



Zurich Classic of New Orleans 7AM Weather Update Friday April 24, 2009



Synopsis: Warm and humid conditions are forecast today with an afternoon high in the lower 80s. Winds will be a bit stronger today and are expected to increase out of the south/southeast at 15-25mph with a few higher gusts possible. High pressure will continue to influence the weather across the Gulf Coast region through the weekend. This will result in warm and muggy conditions along with strong southeast winds each day. Precipitation chances will remain very low, but a stray shower or two can not be completely ruled out on Saturday or Sunday.
