8:00AM Weather Update: Fri, Jan. 25, 2013

Synopsis:

A low pressure system will move slowly east towards the coast today and move across Southern California tonight. This will keep Southern California in a steady stream of light to moderate rain throughout the day. As the low moves closer, can't rule out an isolated t-storm this afternoon. Otherwise, the low pressure system will move into Arizona on Saturday. This will decrease our shower chances, especially during the afternoon. Another low pressure system will drop south on Sunday, bringing another chance for scattered showers and cooler temperatures.

Today:

9AM: Mostly cloudy with a steady light rain.
Temp: 58F RH: 99%
Winds: ESE 3-5mph

Noon: Mostly cloudy with rain likely.
Temp: 62F RH: 95%
Winds: ENE 4-8mph

3PM: Mostly cloudy with sct showers and an isolated t-storm possible.
Temp: 61F RH: 85%
Winds: SW 5-10mph

Extended Outlook:

Sat: Mostly cloudy with a chance of morning showers. Slight chance of showers in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation 40%.
Low: 56F High: 63F
Winds: WSW 8-12mph

Sun: Mostly cloudy with a chance of showers in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation 30%.
Low: 51F High: 59F
Winds: SW 10-15mph
