On Friday, play was suspended at 3:09 p.m. due to a dangerous weather situation. Play resumed at 5:43 p.m. for a total delay of 2 hours and 34 minutes. The course received .82 inches of rain on Friday. The second round was suspended due to darkness at approximately 7:15 p.m.

On Saturday, the second round resumed at 7:35 a.m. with Four of the six matches still on the course. Preferred lies were utilized for the remainder of round two matches.

There were 22 events that had some sort of a suspension/delay on the PGA TOUR during the 2013 season, including round two at the Memorial Tournament.

At the time of the weather delay on Friday, the U.S. Team led in three matches, the International Team led in two matches and one match was all square. On Thursday, at the time of the delay at 2:38 p.m., the U.S. Team led in all six matches.

On Thursday, day one matches were suspended due to a dangerous weather situation at 2:38 p.m. Play resumed at 4 p.m. It was the first weather delay at The Presidents Cup since 2007 at Royal Montreal when the start of the first round was delayed 30 minutes due to rain.

The only time the U.S. Team has trailed after day two at the Presidents Cup was in 1998, when the International Team went on to win 20.5 to 11.5. In 2005, the two teams were tied after day two, but the U.S. Team went on to win.

The International Team has topped the U.S. Team on two occasions in the Foursome format over the opening two days since the start of The Presidents Cup in 1994. The first occasion came in 1998 when the International Team

opened the event by outscoring the U.S. 3.5 to 1.5 in Foursomes before winning the overall competition. The second came in 2003 when the International Team outscored the U.S. 3.5 to 2.5 in the opening Foursome matches. The Presidents Cup ended in a tie in 2003.

U.S. Team captain Fred Couples defeated International Team captain Nick Price 1-up in singles matches in the inaugural President Cup in 1994. Davis Love III and Couples also defeated Price and Bradley Hughes 1-up in Foursome matches that year. These two matches are the only times the two played against each other in the Presidents Cup.

Fred Couples was a Captain's pick in 1998 and 2005. Below are the Captain's Pick results after day two

#### **Match 7**

Phil Mickelson/**Keegan Bradley** (U.S.) defeated Jason Day/**Graham DeLaet** (International), 4 and 3

Mickelson's largest margin of victory in The Presidents Cup came in 2005 in Four-ball when he teamed with Chris DiMarco to defeat Peter Lonard and Nick O'Hern, 6 and 5.

Mickelson/Bradley defeated Lee Westwood/Luke Donald 7 and 6 last year in Foursomes at the Ryder Cup.

Mickelson/Bradley rebounded from their first match-play loss as a team. They were 3-0 in the 2012 Ryder Cup and lost Thursday in round one.

Mickelson holds The Presidents Cup record for most matches played with 44 and for most Foursome matches played with 18.

#### **Match 8**

Ernie Els/**Brendon de Jonge** (International) defeated Bill Haas/Hunter Mahan (U.S.), 4 and 3

In round one, Ernie Els tied Robert Allenby for the most matches lost (17) in The Presidents Cup history. Today, Els recorded the fourth-most wins (18) in Presidents Cup history.

Els' only point at the 2011 Presidents Cup came against Bill Haas/Matt Kuchar in Foursomes in day three with Ryo Ishikawa as his partner.

Brendon de Jonge picked up his first point in The Presidents Cup. Both International Team rookies (de Jonge and Leishman) won their day two matches.

In the 2011 Presidents Cup, Haas/Mahan defeated Jason Day/Aaron Baddeley in Four-ball, 2 and 1.

#### **Match 9** *(In progress)*

Steve Stricker/**Jordan Spieth** (U.S.) defeated **Branden Grace/Richard Sterne** (International), 2 and 1

The Grace/Sterne pairing was the only one featuring two Presidents Cup rookies. They both drop to 0-2-0 this week.

Stricker, who is the oldest player in the field, remains paired with Jordan Spieth, who is the youngest player in the field.

Both International Team rookies (de Jonge and Leishman) won their day two matches.
