7:00AM Weather Update: Sun, Oct. 6, 2013

Synopsis: A strong low pressure system and cold front will bring widespread rain and a few t-storms today through early Monday morning... A weakening line of t-storms is just west of Columbus this morning that could bring a steady rain by the start of play today, but the bulk of the precipitation may just stay to the west. This band will continue to weaken this morning and may see a lull by late morning before another round of showers and a few t-storms moves into the area this afternoon. A few storms could be severe this afternoon into tonight with strong winds and very heavy rainfall. This system should push east of the Columbus by early Monday morning with just some lingering showers. Breezy and colder temperatures can be expected as well with highs in the upper 50's to low 60's.


Today:

9AM:  Showers with and isolated t-storms possible.
Temp: 67F RH: 90%
Winds: S 5-10 mph

Noon:  Mostly cloudy with a slight chance of t-storms.
Temp: 74F RH: 75%
Winds: S 10-15 mph

3PM:  Showers with a chance of t-storms.
Temp: 76F RH: 67%
Winds: S 10-15 gusting to 20 mph

Extended Outlook:

Mon:  Mostly cloudy with a chance of morning showers...breezy and cooler.
Low: 50F High: 60F
Winds: W 10-15 gusting 25 mph
