Hyundai Tournament of Champions Notes

The start of the Hyundai Tournament of Champions on Sunday was initially delayed due to high wind for one hour, with a scheduled start time of 8:10 a.m. HT. Tee times were further delayed by three hours, with the first round officially beginning at 11:10 a.m. Play was suspended due to high wind at 12:21 p.m., with play up to that point declared “null and void”, just as was the case on Friday.

The first round will now begin on Monday at 7:10 a.m. HT, with 36 holes scheduled for Monday and 18 holes on Tuesday.

From the USGA: Rules and Decisions of Golf – Rule 33-2 (d) – Course Unplayable – If the Committee or its authorized representative considers that for any reason the course is not in a playable condition or that there are circumstances that render the proper playing of the game impossible, it may, in match play or stroke play, order a temporary suspension of play or, in stroke play, declare play null and void and cancel all scores for the round in question. When a round is canceled, all penalties incurred in that round are canceled.

Prior to this week (Friday and Sunday), the last time the TOUR declared “play null and void” and restarted a round came at THE PLAYERS Championship in 2005 (second round).

Tournament Scenarios

54 - Official win/FedExCup points/money/100% OWGR points (gets into 2014 Hyundai).

36 - Unofficial win, Official FedExCup points/money/75% OWGR points (does not get into 2014 Hyundai).

The last 54-hole event on TOUR was The Barclays in 2011 (won by Dustin Johnson). The last 36-hole event on the PGA TOUR was the 2005 Northern Trust Open (won by Adam Scott).

If the Hyundai Tournament of Champions ends after 54 holes, it would be the 27th 54-hole event on the PGA TOUR since 1990. A look at the last five 54-hole events on the PGA TOUR (with Dustin Johnson winning the last two):

- 2011 The Barclays (Dustin Johnson)
- 2009 AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am (Dustin Johnson)
- 2005 BellSouth Classic (Phil Mickelson)
- 2002 Southern Farm Bureau Classic (Luke Donald)
- 2000 BellSouth Classic (Phil Mickelson)

Since 1953, this will be the third time that the Hyundai Tournament of Champions has been shortened to 54 holes (1988, 1997).
