ShotLink Keys to Victory for John Merrick

John Merrick - Winner 2013 Northern Trust Open

In his 169th event on the PGA TOUR, the UCLA graduate and Long Beach, Calif., native John Merrick won the Northern Trust Open in his sixth start at Riviera CC to become the first player from Los Angeles County to win the event. Merrick made a par-4 on the second playoff hole (No. 10) to defeat Charlie Beljan. It was Merrick's first playoff on the PGA TOUR.

Merrick has made the FedExCup Playoffs in all 7 seasons of its existence.

Last year he finished a career best 39th in the standings.

Par 5 Dominance at Riviera CC: John Merrick dominated the par 5's at Riviera CC ranking 1st in par 5 scoring average and par 5 performance. He made 7 birdies and 2 eagles on the par 5's this week, including playing par 5 - 11th hole at 5 under par for the week.

Jordan Spieth Notes

Jordan Spieth is coming off his 2nd top 10 of 2013/14 PGA TOUR Season and 11th top 10 since the start of 2013. Spieth is currently ranked 14th in the race for the FedExCup. Spieth is making his 2nd appearance at the Northern Trust Open. In his only other start here he missed the cut in 2012 as an amateur.

Since his professional debut at the Farmers Insurance Open in 2013, Spieth has been one of the hottest players on TOUR. In 28 events on TOUR, Spieth has finished inside the top ten 39.29% of the time.

36-Hole Leader in Last 2 Starts: Jordan Spieth has been in at least a share of the lead through 36-holes in each of his last 2 starts on the PGA TOUR (leader by 1 at the Farmers thru 36 & tied for lead thru 36 at AT&T Pebble Beach). However, despite a strong final round 67 on Pebble Beach last week, he's struggled on the weekends in each of his last 2 starts.

Webb Simpson is making his 6th appearance of the 2013/14 PGA TOUR season and has 4 top 10's ranking 5th in the FEC standings. Webb is making his 3rd appearance at the Northern Trust Open finishing T-15th in 2010 and T-6th in 2013.

Webb Simpson has statistically been all but completely dominant on the PGA TOUR this season.

He currently leads the TOUR for scoring average, scrambling, feet of putts made, and birdie average to name a few.

He's 2^{nd} on TOUR for strokes gained – putting outperforming the TOUR average of over 1 ½ strokes per round with his putter.

Longest streak without a 3-putt: Simpson currently has a streak of 127 consecutive holes without recording a 3-putt on TOUR marking the longest active streak on TOUR.

Jason Dufner Notes

Jason Dufner is making his 5th career start at the Northern Trust Open this week. In his previous 4 starts, he has yet to crack the top 25 and has played just 3 of his 12 career rounds under par on this course.

Dufner is making his first start since finishing T29 at the Sony Open in Hawaii earlier this season. Dufner has played his last 11 (official) consecutive rounds at par or better on the PGA TOUR. This dates back to the 2nd round of the 2013/14 WGC-HSBC Champions event where he finished T-34th.

200 Career Starts: Jason Dufner has made 200 career starts on the PGA TOUR.

He's carded 3 wins, 15 top 5's, 30 top 10's and has a career made cut percentage of 67%.

He's played 314 of his 662 career rounds under par at a combined score of -197 under par.



Keegan Bradley Notes

Despite coming off a 2nd round 80 at the Waste Management Phoenix Open (his 2nd highest round of his career), Keegan Bradley has quietly been one of the most consistent performers on TOUR. Bradley's missed cut at the Waste Management Phoenix Open was his first on TOUR since missing the cut at the 2013 US Open Championship.

Bradley has played his last 8 consecutive rounds at par or better at the Northern Trust Open finishing T-2nd in 2012 and T-16th last year.

Wedge Game Improvements: Keegan's wedge play & short game have improved each year and can be attributed to his consistent play over the last 2 years. Bradley is currently ranked 1st on TOUR for approach shots from 50 to 125 yards averaging a TOUR leading 12 feet 8 inches to the pin from the fairway. This season he's gone onto to convert birdie or better 32% of the time ranking 16th on TOUR for birdie or better percentage from this distance.

One of the Best Driving Performances at the NTO: At the 2013 Northern Trust Open Keegan Bradley averaged 309.4 yards (2nd) off the tee and hit 64.3% (4th) of his fairways leading the field for total driving. "Total Driving" is made up of adding the distance and accuracy ranks for the week and then sorting players by the lowest total value. Since the 1980 Northern Trust Open only 2 other players have had a lower total driving value than Keegan did last year.

Defending Northern Trust Open champion John Merrick is making his 8th start this season and is coming his best finish this season at the Waste Management Phoenix Open where he carded a T-19 finish after opening his week with an opening round 75.

Entering this week, Merrick has been very solid on TOUR with his tee-to-green ranks ranking 9th on TOUR for total driving and 34th for greens in regulation.

However, he currently ranks 139th on TOUR for scrambling and 152nd for strokes gained – putting.

Par 5 Dominance at Riviera CC: John Merrick dominated the par 5's at Riviera CC ranking 1st in par 5 scoring average and par 5 performance. He made 7 birdies and 2 eagles on the par 5's this week, including playing par 5 - 11th hole at 5 under par for the week.

Merrick is the 10th player since 1984 at the Northern Trust Open to play the 11th hole at 5-under par or better in a single week (4 rds). Cameron Beckman holds the record playing the 11th hole a 6-under par for the week (2 eagles and 2 birdies) back in the 2003 Northern Trust Open.

Matt Kuchar is making his first start since the Sony Open in Hawaii and his 4th start this season. Kuchar has consistently carded top ten finishes in each of his first 3 starts.

Hunter Mahan is coming off back-to-back top 6 finishes in his last 2 starts on TOUR (T4 at WMPO & 6th at AT&T Pebble Beach). Mahan carded his career best finish at the Northern Trust Open last year when a T-8th finish in his 8th career start at this event (making his 9th start this week).

Ian Poutler currently ranks 30th in the FedExCup standings thanks in large part to his runner-up finish at the 2013/14 WGC-HSBC Champions event earlier this season. Poulter is coming off of a missed cut at the WMPO.

Poulter is making his first start at the Northern Trust Open since 2007. He's missed the cut in his 2 previous starts here and has yet to break par at this course.

Ian Poulter has ranked inside the top 20 on TOUR when putting inside 5 feet in 6 of the last 8 years on TOUR.

However, his putting ranks fall the as he moves further from the hole.

Justin Rose Notes

Justin Rose is making his first start of the 2013/14 PGA TOUR since his 5th place finish at the 2013/14 WGC-HSBS Champions event. The 2013 U.S. Open champion has 3 top 6 finishes in his last 5 starts on the PGA TOUR dating back to his runner-up finish at the 2013 Barclays.

Tee-to-Green Improvement: Justin's tee-to-green game has drastically improved each year since 2010. In 2010, he ranked T-58th for total driving, 91st for ball striking and 119th for greens in regulation. Last year, he ranked 4th, T-3rd and 9th respectively in these same 3 stats.

Short Game: Rose has ranked inside the top 30 for sand saves in each year from 2009 to 2013. He's also ranked inside the top 35 for scrambling in 3 of the last 4 years (not including 2014 – not officially ranked yet).

Justin is making his 9th career appearance at the Northern Trust Open this week. He's carded top 15 finishes in each of his last 2 starts here finishing T-9th in 2011 and T-13th in 2013. He's played his last 8 consecutive rounds at par or better over this streak of top 15 finishes.
