Jeff Overton

After opening the 2013-14 season with seven-consecutive pars, Jeff Overton added five birdies and an eagle (No. 9) the rest of the round for a bogey-free 7-under 64 and a one-stroke lead over Brian Harman.

Round at a glance: 7/14 fairways in regulation, 15/18 greens in regulation, 27 putts.

Overton is making his third start at the Frys.com Open, missing the cut in 2009 and finishing eighth a year ago with four rounds in the 60s (68-69-68-66).

This marks the fifth time Overton has been the leader/co-leader after the first round on the PGA TOUR (2008 Reno-Tahoe Open/finished T37, 2008 Turning Stone Resort Championship/finished T10, 2010 Crowne Plaza Invitational at Colonial/finished T3, 2011 HP Byron Nelson Championship/finished T8).

Overton is coming off of a 108th place finish in the FedExCup, with top-10 finishes at the Valero Texas Open (T7) and Sony Open in Hawaii (8th).

First-Round Notes

Since moving to CordeValle GC in 2010, the only first-round leader to hang on for the win was Rocco Mediate in 2010. His opening-round, 7-under 64 was good for a one-stroke lead over three others.

A year ago, Nick O'Hern opened with a 9-under 62 for a three-shot first-round lead en route to T22 honors, while eventual champion Jonas Blixt opened with a 5-under 66.

Additional Player Notes

Defending champion Jonas Blixt carded an opening-round 2-under 69.

Michael Putnam, the 2013 Web.com Tour Regular Season leading money winner, opened with a 4-under 67. John Peterson, leading money winner following the Web.com Tour Finals, posted a 3-under 68.

Playing on sponsor exemptions, Max Homa (69) and Justin Thomas (72) both made their PGA TOUR professional debuts Thursday.

Several players on Major Medical Extensions returned to the PGA TOUR this week, including two-time U.S. Open champion Retief Goosen (75), Spencer Levin (71) and Paul Goydos (70).

Making his debut as a PGA TOUR member, 21-year-old Hideki Matsuyama opened with a 1-under 70. He is coming off a 1-3-1 performance for the International Team in last week's Presidents Cup. Matsuyama turned professional in 2013, finishing inside the top 10 at both the U.S. Open and The Open Championship en route to earning his PGA TOUR card via the non-member FedExCup points list.
