ShotLink Keys to Victory for Michael Thompson

Michael Thompson - Winner 2013 Honda Classic

Michael Thompson picked up his first career title at The Honda Classic in his 61st PGA TOUR start. Thompson is the first American to win The Honda Classic since Mark Wilson in 2007. International players have won The Honda Classic seven of the last nine years. Michael made it 5 out of the last 5 winners at The Honda Classic to convert their 54-hole lead into victory (last 5 winners shot par or better in final round).

FedExCup Leap: In his first 4 events of 2013, Thompson only made one cut and finished T-78th at the Farmers Insurance Open earning just 1 FedExCup point ranking T191st in the standings. With his win last season he vaulted up to 11th in the standings moving up 180 spots.

In the final round just 5 players (Thompson, Jones, Lynn, Ogilvy, Schwartzel) were under par at PGA National setting the record for fewest players under par in a round at this event since 2007 (6 players 2008 Round 4).

On The Greens: Thompson ranked in the top 10 in several key statistics, most importantly making key putts at key moments. In the final round Michael made 111'9" of putts including 3 putts over 10 feet (49 footer for eagle #3 a 12'5" putt on #5 for birdie and a 18'10" putt for par at #6).

Michael ranked 5th in strokes gained – putting outperforming the field by nearly a stroke and a half per round with his putter. Thompson was ranked T1st in the field going perfect from 4-8 feet. His 4'9" par save on the par 4, 10th hole (#1 ranked toughest hole of the week playing 4.403) kept his round going making 7 of 7 from this distance.

Scoring: Michael Thompson ranked T2nd in par 4 performance playing the par 4's 2 under-par for the week and 7 shots better than the field average of 5 over par. For the week, his back 9 scoring average (34.25) was clutch ranking T2nd playing the back nine 3 under par. In the final round, Thompsons even par back 9 was 2 and a half shots better than the field average of 37.37.



2007-2013 The Honda Classic Keys to Winning

Since 2007, winners of the Honda Classic have shown solid iron play despite inaccuracy off the tee. Last year's Champion Michael Thompson was the first player to rank inside the top 10 in fairways and greens ranking 9th in driving accuracy and 5th in greens in regulation for the week.

Rory Sabbatini is the only champion at this event to rank outside the top 10 in greens in regulation for the week.

Par 3 Scoring: Out of the 7 Champions at PGA National (Champion Course) only 2 players have played the par 3's over par for the week (2007 Mark Wilson & 2010 Camilo Villegas). However, no champion at the Honda Classic has played the par 3's worse than 1 over par for the week. Rory McIlroy has the best relative to par score on the par 3's since 2007 playing the 3 par's at 4 under for the week. Rory made 5 birdies and 1 bogey on the par 3's including playing holes 15 & 17 at 3 under.

All Champions of the Honda Classic have ranked inside the top 25 in strokes gained-putting in their respective victory. The average total strokes gained-putting for the winner of the Honda Classic is **+4.71** strokes better than the field with the putter.

Putting Inside and Outside 10 Feet: The Champions of the Honda Classic miss an average of 6.5 putts from inside 10 feet at PGA National (Champion Course). However, they make an average of over 9 putts outside of 10 feet for the week.

Tiger Woods Notes

Tiger Woods is making his 3rd appearance as a professional at the Honda Classic with a T-2nd place finish in 2012 and a T-37th last season. In his only appearance of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Tiger failed to make it to the final round of the Farmers Insurance Open by missing the Saturday cut.

Tiger ranks 225th in the race for the FedExCup. Earning just 1 point at the Farmers Insurance Open, Woods finds himself 1,829 points behind FedExCup leader Jimmy Walker.

In 2009, Tiger Woods carded 6 wins, 14 top tens and 16 top twenty-five finishes in just 17 starts. However, from 2010 to 2011 he was able to accumulate just 4 top tens in 21 starts on TOUR. 2012 and 2013, Tiger has combined for 8 wins (23% winning percentage), 17 top 10's (finishing inside top 10 49% of the time) and 23 top 25's in only 35 TOUR starts.

Off the Tee Improvements

Tiger Woods made major improvements with his tee game in the last 2 seasons finishing the season ranked 6th in total driving in 2012 (marking his best finish in this category since he led the TOUR back in 2000) and 17th in 2013. This marked the 1st time since the 1999 & 2000 PGA TOUR seasons where he has finished inside the top 20 in back to back seasons in total driving.

Tiger Woods has steadily improved in strokes gained putting since 2010 ranking 22nd outperforming the TOUR by nearly a half a stroke per round (+.424) with his putter.

Woods rank of 22nd in SG-putting in 2013 marked his best performance on the greens in this category since ranking 1st in 2009.

Tiger made 697 of 784 (88.90%) attempts from inside 10 feet ranking **9th** on TOUR. This also marked Tiger's best year in this category since his 2009 PGA TOUR season where he went 776 of 858 (90.44%) ranking 1st on TOUR.



Zach Johnson Notes

Zach ranks 6th in the FEC standings on the strength of 1 win (Hyundai TOC), 3 top 10's and 4 top 25 finishes in 6 starts.

Since the start of 2013, Zach has the T-3rd most top 10's on TOUR. In 30 starts on TOUR, Zach Johnson has finished inside the top 10 a total of 11 times (36.67%).

Zach Johnson is known not necessarily for his distance off the tee however, he has been one of the most accurate players in driving accuracy in the last 10 seasons. Zach has ranked inside the top 30 in driving accuracy in 9 of the last 10 PGA TOUR seasons and has ranked inside the top 10 in 6 of the 10 seasons. The only year he was ranked outside of the top 30 was his 2nd year on TOUR in 2005 ranking 47th.

Keegan Bradley Notes

Keegan Bradley currently ranks 41st in the FEC standings on the strength of 1 top 10 (CIMB Classic) and 5 top 25 finishes this season. Keegan is making his 4th start at the Honda Classic and has played 6 of his last 8 rounds at par or better at PGA National resulting in a T-12th place finish in 2012 and a T-4th finish last season.

Wedge Game Improvements: Keegan's wedge play & short game have improved each year and can be attributed to his consistent play over the last 2 years. Bradley is currently ranked 2nd on TOUR for approach shots from 50 to 125 yards averaging a TOUR 13 feet 11 inches to the pin from the fairway.

Keegan is 1 of 3 players on TOUR to rank inside the top 15 in Total Driving the last 3 seasons (Boo Weekley & Brandt Jobe).

This Season, Keegan currently ranks 4th in Total Driving ranking T17th in Driving Distance (300.9 yards) and 65th in Driving Accuracy (62.09%).

Luke Donald is making his 3rd appearance of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Donald currently ranks 163rd in the race for the FedExCup. The 2006 the Honda Classic Champion is making his 6th appearance at this event and 4th at PGA National (Champion Course).

Henrik Stenson Notes

Defending FedExCup Champion Henrik Stenson is making his 3rd appearance of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Stenson currently ranks 144th in the standings coming off a 2nd round loss to Louis Oosthuizen at last week's WGC-Accenture Match Play Championship.

In 2012, Henrik Stenson ranked over 40th in driving accuracy, greens in regulation, total driving and ball striking. However, last season Henrik showed premium ball striking ranking 1st in greens in regulation and 3rd in total driving.

Sergio Garcia Notes

Sergio Garcia is making his 4th appearance of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Garcia currently ranks 56th in the FEC standings on the strength of 2 top 10 finishes and 3 top 25's.

In 3 appearances at the Honda Classic, Sergio leads all players in greens in regulation percentage at PGA National. In 12 rounds (216 holes) at PGA National, Sergio has hit 69.44% of his greens in regulation.

Since the inception of strokes gained-putting in 2004, Sergio Garcia has been struggling on the greens. From 2004 until 2011, Sergio only gained strokes to the field in one season (2007). During this time frame Sergio lost a total of **-62.501** strokes to the field with his putter.

However, in 2012 & 2013, Sergio has had 2 of his best putting seasons on TOUR ranking 26th in 2012 and 8th last season. Sergio's total strokes gained-putting the last 2 seasons is **+45.956**, outperforming himself by a total of **+108.457** strokes better than his previous 8 seasons on TOUR.

Billy Horschel Notes

Billy Horschel currently ranks 40th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 top 10 (Hyundai TOC, T6) and 5 top 25 finishes on TOUR.

Horschel is coming off a second round loss to eventual Champion Jason Day at last week's Accenture Match Play Championship. In 8 events this season, Horschel has only finished outside the top 25 twice (WGC-HSBC Champions T-34th & a missed cut at the Waste Management Phoenix Open).

In 2013, Billy Horschel was among the best on TOUR putting from 10 to 15 feet ranking 3rd in this category making 38.43% of his putts. He had the T8th most attempts from this distance with 229. There were only 8 players with the same or more attempts from 10 to 15 feet. No body made more putts during the 2013 FedExCup season from this distance than Horschel.

Adam Scott Notes

Adam Scott is making his 3rd start at the Honda Classic and first since 2011. In his only 2 starts of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Adam Scott has 2 top 10 finishes (T6 Hyundai TOC & T8 Sony Open). Adam currently ranks 101st in the FEC standings.

In Adam Scott's 2 victories of 2013 he only made 1 bogey in either of his final rounds. The lone bogey came on the first hole of the final round of the Masters Tournament. Scott then played the last 35 holes at a solid 9 under par including being bogey free on the back 9 in both events.

In 2013, Adam Scott averaged 34.87 in back 9 scoring ranking 2nd on TOUR. His average of 34.87 was nearly a stroke better than the TOUR average of 35.74.

Phil Mickelson Notes

Phil Mickelson is making his 6th appearance of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season and currently ranks T-83rd in the FEC standings. Phil is making his 4th appearance at the Honda Classic and first since 2002 where he finished T-11th.

Phil Mickelson is 1 of 3 players to rank inside the top 30 of the FedExCup in every season. Mickelson is the only player to rank inside the top 15 in every season of the FedExCup.

On The Greens: Phil Mickelson has been fearless on the greens the last 2 seasons ranking 6th and 10th in strokes gained-putting outperforming the TOUR by a combined **+1.256** strokes per round. Phil's average of +1.256 per round is over a stroke and a half **(1.543)** better than his combined strokes gained-putting in 2010 and 2011 of -0.287.

In 2010 and 2011, Phil made a combined **35** of 236 (14.8%) putts from 15 to 20 feet ranking outside the top 100 in both seasons. However in 2012 and 2013, Phil made **50** of 218 (22.9%) putts from this distance making 15 more putts in 18 less attempts.

Phil made a total of **21** (21 of 434) putts from over 25 feet in 2010 and 2011 combined ranking 111th in 2010 and 139th in 2012. However in the last 2 seasons, Phil made nearly double **(41 putts made)** from over 25 feet (41 of 479) in the last 2 seasons ranking inside the top 10 in both seasons.

McDowell is making his 6th appearance at the Honda Classic finishing in the top 10 in his last 3 starts (T6 in 2011 and T9 in both 2012 & 2013).

Rickie Fowler Notes

Rickie Fowler is coming off a 3rd place finish at last week's WGC-Accenture Match Play Championship and moved from 130th to 49th in the FedExCup standings.

Rickie is making his 5th appearance at the Honda Classic finishing T-7th (2012) and T-13th (2013) in his last two starts.

Rickie has been working to improve all areas of his game. However, his play from on and around the greens has improved dramatically from 2012 to 2013.

Fowler improved from ranking 106th in scrambling to 56th on TOUR in 2013.
