7:00AM Weather Update: Sat, August 23, 2014



Synopsis: The last piece of upper level energy will rotate through the region today and could produce some widely scattered showers as it passes. The best chance for seeing showers will be to our north and west this afternoon. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies can be expected today with highs in the mid to upper 70's. High pressure will build south out of Canada tonight and dominate our weather through the middle of next week. Mostly sunny skies will return tomorrow with highs in the low 80's.
