

## 2014 Travelers Championship Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Ken Duke

Ken Duke picked up his first career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 187<sup>th</sup> career start on TOUR moving to 20<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings.

Duke relied on his play from on and around the greens en route to victory at TPC River Highlands.

Entering the 2013 Travelers Ken Duke ranked 99<sup>th</sup> on TOUR for scrambling from around the greens (57.9%). However, his short game was on point at TPC River Highlands salvaging par or better on 21 of 27 missed greens ranking 3<sup>rd</sup> in this category.

He was also sharp with the putter ranking 10<sup>th</sup> for strokes gained – putting, 2<sup>nd</sup> for one-putts and T-1<sup>st</sup> when putting from 15 to 25 feet.

On a course that was ranked 2nd in lowest percentage of birdie or better from the fairway. No one was better at this event last year than Bubba Watson making 18 birdies or better from the fairway out of 53 attempts (34.0%). When in the fairway Bubba made birdie or better 34% of the time while the field average was 17.5%.

The par 4, 15th measures 296 yards on the scorecard ranking 1st on TOUR for shortest par 4's. 85.9% of players went for the par 4 ranking 2nd on TOUR for highest par 4 going for the green percentage. The 15th hole at River Highlands had the most par 4 eagles in 2013 yielded 10 to the field.

## Broadcast Window Notes

### 2014 Travelers Championship *(featured groups)*

#### Dustin Johnson

Dustin Johnson is making his 3<sup>rd</sup> appearance at the Travelers Championship (2009, W/D & 2008, T-34th). Dustin Johnson is coming off a T-4th at the U.S. Open last week and remains in the 4th position of the FedExCup standings.

**7 Straight Years with a Win:** Dustin Johnson now has at least 1 win in each of his last 7 seasons on the PGA TOUR (dating back to 2008). Phil Mickelson is the only other player on TOUR with at least 1 win each season since the start of the 2008 season (Mickelson's streak extends back to 2004).

Dustin currently ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in the race for the FedExCup and is looking to stay inside the top 15 for the 6th consecutive season. In the last 5 seasons, Dustin Johnson, Phil Mickelson and Nick Watney are the only 3 players to rank inside the top 15.

Dustin Johnson currently ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in Driving Distance in 2013-14, averaging 312 yards on measured drives off of the tee. Dustin is just 1 of 26 players on TOUR this season to hit over 50% of his measured drives on TOUR over 300 yards (54 of 74 drives).

Dustin Johnson is the 2<sup>nd</sup> most aggressive player on TOUR this season in terms of going for the green. So far this season, Dustin has gone for the green 75% of the time on par 5's and reachable par 4's.

When going for the green, he has been successful 28% of the time ranking 26<sup>th</sup> on TOUR. Because of his aggressive nature, Dustin currently has the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest par 5 scoring average on TOUR this season (4.49).

No one hits it closer to the flag stick from the fairway than Dustin Johnson. Dustin ranks 1st in fairway proximity averaging 27'11" to the flag stick. His average is nearly 5 feet closer than the TOUR average of 32'6".

## Ken Duke

Defending Travelers Championship Champion, Ken Duke makes his 6th appearance at this event. Duke currently ranks 145th in the FedExCup standings and is in search of his first top 10 of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.

Ken has made a big improvement this season ranking 24th in greens in regulation hitting 758 of 1,116 greens (67.92%).

Ken Duke ranked T-62nd in greens in regulation out of 74 players to make the cut at the 2013 Travelers Championship.

However, it was his play from around the greens that kept him in contention. Duke ranked 3rd in scrambling at this event last season, salvaging par on 21 of 27 (77.78%) missed greens.

## Marc Leishman

Marc Leishman makes his 16th start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season and currently ranks 52nd in the race for the FedExCup.

The 2012 Travelers Championship Champion ranked 48<sup>th</sup> in the field for strokes gained – putting en route to his victory at the Travelers Championship. However, you have to look at his round by round performance on the greens to uncover his putting performance.

In the first 3 rounds, Leishman lost over 3 ½ strokes to the field with his putter (-3.70 total strokes lost putting) ranking 68<sup>th</sup> in the field out of 70 players to make the cut. However, in the final round, Marc gained a field leading +3.89 strokes on the field with his putter en route to his final round 62. In the final round Leishman outperformed his first 3 round total on the greens by over 7 ½ shots.

Marc Leishman has played 417 career rounds where strokes gained-putting was calculated. His performance in the final round of the 2012 Travelers Championship marked his 4th best putting performance in a round of his PGA TOUR career.

## Matt Kuchar

Matt Kuchar is coming off a T-12th at last week's U.S. Open Championship. Since 2010, Matt Kuchar has played 111 events on the PGA TOUR. Of those 111 events he has only missed 7 cuts (93% of cuts made).

In 16 events this season, Matt Kuchar has 9 top 10 finishes including his victory at the RBC Heritage. Kuchar has finished inside the top ten 56% of the time and inside the top twenty five 81% of the time (13 top 25's of 16 events played this season).

Kuchar finished T-8th in his last appearance at the Travelers Championship in 2012. His aggressive play at TPC River Highlands paid off leading the field in going for the green birdie or better percentage. Matt Kuchar was 6 under par when going for the greens on par 5's and reachable par 4's at TPC River Highlands making birdie or better on 5 of 6 attempts.

**Top 30 in Key Stats:** Matt Kuchar has performed better than the TOUR average in a number of different categories. He currently ranks inside the top 30 in driving accuracy, strokes gained-putting, 3-putt avoidance, scrambling, birdie average and scoring average.

## Sergio Garcia

Sergio Garcia currently ranks 34th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 5 top 10's and 7 top 25's in only 9 events. Sergio makes his 3rd start at the Travelers Championship finishing T-20th in 2002 & T-43rd in 2009.

Sergio Garcia currently ranks 34th in the FedExCup standings. Garcia looks to make it back to the TOUR Championship presented by Coca-Cola for the 5th time in his career and 3rd consecutive season.

Since 2010, Sergio Garcia has played 73 events on TOUR and has only missed 6 cuts (91.8% cuts made %). Sergio is only 1 of 7 players who have missed 9 or fewer cuts in 50 or more starts on TOUR.

Zach Johnson ranks 4th on TOUR in putting from over 25 feet this season. Zach has made 23 of 228 putts from over 25 feet this season (10.09%).



## Ben Crane

Ben Crane moved from 150<sup>th</sup> to 41<sup>st</sup> in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the 2014 FedEx St. Jude Classic (currently 44th) 2 weeks ago. Crane picked up his 5<sup>th</sup> career victory on TOUR and first since winning the 2011 The McGladrey Classic. Ben Crane became the 8<sup>th</sup> winner of the FedEx St. Jude Classic to have at least a share of the lead after every round.

**No Birdies in Final Round:** Crane made 13 birdies in his first 36-holes of the week. However, he made just 2 birdies in his final 36-holes including no birdies in the final round. Ben Crane was 1 of just 2 players without a birdie in the final round (Davis Love III) on TPC Southwind.

Crane becomes the 3<sup>rd</sup> PGA TOUR winner since 1983 (5 total wins by 3 players) without a birdie in the final round and first since Justin Leonard accomplished this feat en route to victory at the 2005 FedEx St. Jude.

**30 Missed Greens for Crane:** Ben Crane missed 30 total greens at TPC Southwind ranking T-47<sup>th</sup> in the field for greens in regulation. 30 missed greens ties Patrick Reed for the most missed greens by a winner on TOUR this season. Reed also missed 30 greens en route to victory at the WGC-Cadillac Championship.

Entering the FedEx St. Jude, Crane ranked 122<sup>nd</sup> on TOUR for scrambling from around the greens, 90<sup>th</sup> on TOUR for strokes gained – putting and 123<sup>rd</sup> when putting from inside 10 feet. However, Crane relied on his short game and putting en route to victory on TPC Southwind.

For the week, he ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> for scrambling salvaging par or better on 25 of 30 missed greens. On the greens, he outperformed the field by over 2 strokes per round with the putter leading the field for strokes gained – putting.

### Hunter Mahan

The 2007 Travelers Championship Champion, Hunter Mahan is making his 13th appearance at this event. Mahan currently ranks 68th in the race for the FedExCup on the strength of 4 top 10's and 4 top 25 finishes.

## **Bubba Watson**

Currently 2nd in the FedExCup standings, Bubba Watson trails FedExCup point's leader Jimmy Walker by only 274 points. Watson is the only player in the field that can overtake the #1 position in the standings with a solo 2nd place finish or better.
