ShotLink Keys to Victory for Angel Cabrera

It was Cabrera's 64-64 (128) performance on the weekend that sealed his 3rd career victory on the PGA TOUR. His final 36-hole score of 128 equaled the lowest final 36-hole cumulative score on TOUR last season.

Angel Cabrera had every facet of his game in sync en route to victory. He ranked 2nd in Total Driving, 4th for Driving Accuracy, 1st for Ball Striking hit a field leading 79% of his Greens in Regulation, ranked T-6th for Proximity to the Hole and 5th on the greens for Strokes Gained: Putting.

Career Putting Week: Cabrera's 15 putts made from outside 10 feet was both the best by any player in the field and a new career best for Cabrera on the PGA TOUR. His previous best of 12 putts made over 10 feet came during the 2007 WGC-Cadillac Championship.

Angel converted a perfect 52 of 52 putts from inside 5 feet (T1), made just 3 of 10 putts from 5 to 10 feet (last in the field) and converted 15 of 53 (1st in the field) from outside 10 feet.

Cabrera's make percentage from 5 to 10 feet was nearly the same as his make percentage from outside 10 feet.

176 yard hole-out: Angel Cabrera holed-out for eagle on the 13th hole from 176 yards in the final round en route to victory. His 176 yard hole-out marked the 2nd longest by a winner in the final round since 2003 on courses where ShotLink is used to capture laser data.

Angel Cabrera

Defending Champion of the Greenbrier Classic, Angel Cabrera is set to make his 17th start of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Cabrera finds himself in similar position as he did last season before his win at The Old White TPC.

Angel converted a perfect 52 of 52 putts from inside 5 feet (T1), made just 3 of 10 putts from 5 to 10 feet (last in the field) and converted 15 of 53 (1st in the field) from outside 10 feet.

Patrick Reed

Patrick Reed is scheduled to make his 3rd start at The Greenbrier Classic. In his first two he has a T-26th place finish in 2014 and missed the cut in 2013. Reed currently ranks 7th in the FedExCup standings. Reed is coming off only his 2nd missed cut of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season at last week's Travelers Championship.

Patrick Reed ranks 187th of 198 ranked players on TOUR in Driving Accuracy hitting 500 of 935 (53.48%) of possible fairways on TOUR. However, Reed is dialed in from the rough ranking 7th on TOUR in Rough Proximity.

Keegan Bradley

Keegan Bradley finished T-4th at The Greenbrier Classic last season closing out the event with a final round 66 which moved him from T-19th inside the top 5.

Keegan Bradley ranked inside the top 10 in several categories at last year's Greenbrier Classic, including Greens in Regulation ranking T-4th in the field (76.39%, 55 of 72).

Keegan Bradley combines Driving Distance and Driving Accuracy better than anyone the last 5 seasons on TOUR. Since 2011, Keegan Bradley is the only player on TOUR who has ranked inside the top 15 in Total Driving.

Bill Haas

Bill Haas is set to make his 5th start at The Greenbrier Classic. In his 4 starts he has 2 top 10's (2013, T9 & 2011, T2) 3 top 25 finishes. Haas has played 11 of his 16 rounds in the 60's and 15 of 16 rounds at par or better at The Old White TPC.

Bill Haas has the best Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green average amongst players who have played 11 or more rounds at the Old White TPC. Bill has outperformed the field by over a stroke per round +1.402 in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green.

Bubba Watson

Bubba Watson is coming off his 8th PGA TOUR victory at last week's Travelers Championship. Only Rory McIlroy has more PGA TOUR wins (11 by McIlroy) since 2010 than Bubba Watson (Watson is tied with Tiger Woods with 8 victories over this time frame). With his victory, Watson moved inside the top 5 of the FedExCup for the 48th week since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season (2nd most on TOUR over this time frame).

Watson moved from 12th to 3rd in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the Travelers Championship. Only Jimmy Walker (65 weeks) has ranked inside the top 5 of the standings more weeks than Watson since the start of the 2013-14 FedExCup Race.

13.3 Yards Shorter Approach Shot Remaining than Everyone

Last week, the field average distance remaining from the hole after a tee shot on a par 4 or par 5 was 154.8 yards. Bubba Watson was the only player in the field who averaged less than 130 yards from the tee on all tee shots. His 127.4 yard average was 27.4 yards better than the field average and 13.3 yards better than the next best player (Rodgers: 140. 7yards).

New ShotLink Record: Watson's 127.4 yard average after his tee shots at the 2015 Travelers Championship is a new PGA TOUR record by a winner in the ShotLink era (since 2003). Watson is the only PGA TOUR winner to average less than 130 yards remaining after a tee shot in more than 1 victory in the ShotLink era.

Scrambling Success: In 2013 Bubba Watson ranked 150th on TOUR for Scrambling from around the greens salvaging par or better on 54% of his missed greens. His scrambling ranks have drastically improved in the last 2 seasons (74th last year and currently 6th on TOUR after the Travelers Championship) and proved to be one of the largest contributing factors to his success on TPC River Highlands.

Paul Casey

Paul Casey is coming off his 2nd Playoff loss of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season at the Travelers Championship. Casey moved from 33rd to 16th in the FedExCup standings after his finish at the Travelers Championship. Paul is seeking to get back to the TOUR Championship for the 2nd time in his career and first since 2010.

Paul Casey led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green & Greens in Regulation at the Travelers Championship. This marked the first time he has led the field in both categories in the same event and the 7th time he has led the field in Greens in Regulation.

Louis Oosthuizen

Louis Oosthuizen currently ranks 46th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 5 top 10's and 7 top 25 finishes this season. Louis is coming off a missed cut at last week's Travelers Championship. In round 1 at the Travelers Championship, Louis failed to make a birdie for only the 7th time in his career. For 36 holes he was only able to card 1 birdie marking just the 2nd time in his career where he has only made 1 birdie in his first 36 holes in an event on TOUR (2012 U.S. Open).

Louis Oosthuizen currently ranks 46th in the FedExCup standings, marking his best position since the 2012 PGA TOUR season.

Steve Stricker is set to make his 6th start of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season and first since finishing T-40th at the Memorial Tournament a few weeks ago.

Since 2010, Steve Stricker has the fewest cuts missed on TOUR. In 86 events on TOUR, Steve Stricker has only missed 2 cuts.

David Lingmerth

David Lingmerth currently ranks 32nd in the FedExCup standings and is on track for his best FedExCup finish in his career. Lingmerth ranked 75th in the FEC standings in 2013 and 134th last season. David picked up his 1st PGA TOUR victory a few weeks ago at the Memorial Tournament.

David Lingmerth recorded his best Strokes Gained: Putting performance in his career at Muirfield Village GC outperforming the field by +1.574 strokes per round with his putter. David was solid on the greens ranking 4th in putting from 4-8 feet making 14 of 15 from this distance. David made nearly 5 putts more than the field average in Putting from Outside 10 feet making a total of 10 for the week.

Tiger Woods

Tiger Woods is set to make his 2nd appearance at The Greenbrier Classic (2012, Missed Cut) and 7th of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Plagued by injuries the last 5 years have not been to kind to arguable the best player of all time. Tiger has triple the number of W/D's in the last 5 years (6) than his first 13 years on TOUR and nearly double of the number of missed cuts made with 8.

With only 8 weeks remaining in the FedExCup season, Tiger Woods finds himself ranked 202nd in the standings. With only 58 FedExCup points recorded (56 from the Masters Tournament) Tiger seeks to climb up the standings with a solid finish this week. Not officially ranked in any official stats this season (due to not having enough rounds played), Tiger Woods has shown some better consistency with his putter. Tiger has only missed 16 putts from inside 10 feet and is 5 of 16 from 20-25 feet.
