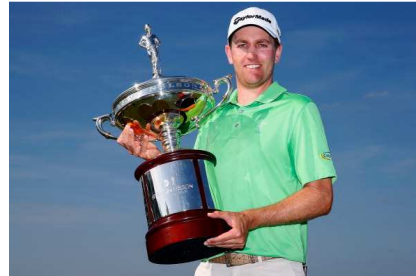


## 2015 AT&T Byron Nelson Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Brendon Todd

At the age of 28, Brendon Todd picked up his 1<sup>st</sup> PGA TOUR victory in his 77<sup>th</sup> career start on TOUR. Brendon Todd hit 40 of 56 (71%) of his fairways from the tee leading the field for Driving Accuracy. Brendon ranked T-55<sup>th</sup> for Greens in Regulation (59%) on TPC Four Seasons marking the lowest G.I.R. rank by a winner since Ken Duke ranked 62<sup>nd</sup> in the field for Greens in Regulation en route to victory at the 2013 Travelers Championship.

**Short Game:** Todd missed 29 greens in regulation and successfully salvaged par or better 25 times (86%) leading the field for Scrambling.

Since 1992, just 7 TOUR winners have led the field for Scrambling when missing 29 or more greens in regulation.

Brendon Todd entered the week ranked 11<sup>th</sup> on TOUR for Strokes Gained: Putting outperforming the TOUR by +.623 strokes per round with his putter. His solid putting numbers continued as he led the field for Strokes Gained: Putting, Putts per Round and 3-Putt Avoidance.

Brendon Todd outperformed the field by +2.446 strokes per round in Strokes Gained: Putting. This works out to a career best +9.8 total shots better than the field average with his putter on TPC Four Seasons.

### 2015 AT&T Byron Nelson *(featured groups)*

#### Jordan Spieth

FedExCup leader, Jordan Spieth is set to make his 5<sup>th</sup> start at the AT&T Byron Nelson. In 4 starts at this event he has yet to finish inside the top 15 (2014: T-37<sup>th</sup>, 2013: T-68<sup>th</sup>, 2011: T-32<sup>nd</sup>, 2010: T-16<sup>th</sup>). Jordan is coming off a T-2<sup>nd</sup> place finish at last week's Crowne Plaza Invitational.

The total number of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes on the PGA TOUR by 21 year old Jordan Spieth marking the most by any player since 1970.

Jordan recorded his 16<sup>th</sup> top 5 finish on TOUR last week. His 16 top 5's is the most of any player since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season.

In 64 starts as a professional Jordan has finished inside the top 5, 25.0% of the time.

Jordan Spieth ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green outperforming the TOUR by +1.51 strokes per round. Spieth is the only player who ranks inside the top 10 in both SG: Tee-to-Green & Putting.

Since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Jordan Spieth has been one of the hottest putters on TOUR. On the Greens, Jordan Spieth has ranked inside the top 20 in several putting categories including, Strokes Gained: Putting, One-Putt percentage and Putting from 15 to 25 feet.

Jordan Spieth has gone from 20<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Putting last season to T-9<sup>th</sup> this season.

Jordan is averaging +0.60 strokes per round better than the TOUR in Strokes Gained: Putting.

Brooks Koepka is set to make his 11<sup>th</sup> appearance of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season and currently ranks 24<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings.

Zach Johnson lead the field in both Driving Accuracy and GIR's last week marking the 3<sup>rd</sup> time a player has ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in both categories in the same week this season.



### **Sangmoon Bae**

Sangmoon Bae picked up his first career victory in his 43<sup>rd</sup> start on the PGA TOUR at the 2013 AT&T Byron Nelson. Bae ranked T-9<sup>th</sup> in the field for Greens in Regulation hitting 73.6% of his greens at TPC Four Seasons Resort. However, Bae can attribute a large portion of his success in his first PGA TOUR victory to his performance on the greens.

**The field on the greens:** The average player at the 2013 AT&T Byron Nelson made 4.6 putts from beyond 10 feet, 1.2 putts from beyond 20 feet and converted an average of 277 total feet of putts on the greens.

On the other hand, Sangmoon Bae ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in Strokes Gained: Putting outperforming the field by +1.753 strokes per round with his putter. He had One-Putts on 34 of 72 holes (47% - 3<sup>rd</sup> most), converted a field T-leading 12 putts (of 43 attempts – 27.9% from outside of 10 feet (6 of which were from outside 20 feet – also 1<sup>st</sup> in the field) and made a total of 389 feet 5 inches of putts on the green (2<sup>nd</sup> most Total Feet of Putts).

The last time Bae made 12 putts from outside of 10 feet came during his previous best finish on TOUR at the 2012 Valspar Championship when he lost in a playoff to Luke Donald.

Since 2003, Bae is just the 11<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR winner to make 6 or more putts from beyond 20 feet en route to victory and the first winner to do so since Phil Mickelson made 6 putts from outside 20 feet en route to his victory at the 2013 Waste Management Phoenix Open.

The average player made 6.5% of his putting efforts from beyond 20 feet at the 2013 AT&T Byron Nelson.

Sang-Moon Bae made an impressive 6 of 26 putts (23%) from this distance leading the field en route to victory.

### Dustin Johnson

In 5 starts at the AT&T Byron Nelson, Dustin Johnson has recorded 3 top 10's, 4 top 25 finishes and a T-63<sup>rd</sup> (2008).
