### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Adam Scott

Adam Scott picked up his 11<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR victory at the Crowne Plaza Invitational. Scott made double bogey 6 on the 9<sup>th</sup> hole in the final round. He's now the 3<sup>rd</sup> Crowne Plaza Invitational champion in the last 10 years to make double bogey in the final round en route to victory (last: Zach Johnson – 2012 – 72<sup>nd</sup> hole).

Adam Scott ranked T-8<sup>th</sup> for driving accuracy at Colonial CC. However, when missing the fairway he performed well ranking 4<sup>th</sup> for greens in regulation from other than the fairway and 1<sup>st</sup> in the field for rough proximity averaging nearly 18 feet closer to the hole than the field average of 42 feet.

Adam Scott averaged just over 24 feet to the pin on all approach shots from the rough at Colonial Country Club. His field leading average was over 6 feet better than the next best player and nearly 18 feet better than the field average of 42 feet from the rough.

**Par 3 Dominance:** Adam Scott dominated the par 3's at Colonial Country Club playing them at a field T-leading 5-under par for the week. This marked Scott's best par 3 performance in an event on the PGA TOUR.

### 2015 Crowne Plaza Invitational *(featured groups)*

#### Jordan Spieth

FedExCup leader, Jordan Spieth is set to make his 3<sup>rd</sup> start at the Crowne Plaza Invitational. In 2 starts at this event he has yet to finish outside the top 15 (2014, T-14th & 2013, T-7<sup>th</sup>). Jordan is coming off only his 2<sup>nd</sup> missed cut of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season at THE PLAYERS.

Jordan recorded his 15th top 5 finish on TOUR at the Masters. His 15 top 5's is the T-most since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season.

In 63 starts as a professional Jordan has finished inside the top 5, 23.8% of the time.

Jordan Spieth ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green outperforming the TOUR by +1.44 strokes per round. Spieth the only player who ranks inside the top 10 in both SG: Tee-to-Green & Putting.

Since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Jordan Spieth has been one of the hottest putters on TOUR. On the Greens, Jordan Spieth has ranked inside the top 20 in several putting categories including, Strokes Gained: Putting, One-Putt percentage and Putting from 15 to 25 feet.

Jordan Spieth has gone from 20<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Putting last season to 6<sup>th</sup> this season.

Jordan is averaging +0.64 strokes per round better than the TOUR in Strokes Gained: Putting.

Jordan Spieth had 17 birdies in 2014 and 20 in 2013 at the Crowne Plaza Invitational. His 37 total birdies over this time frame marks the most of any player at this event.

## Hunter Mahan

Hunter Mahan is set to make his 12th appearance at the Crowne Plaza Invitational and is in search of his 5 straight made cut at this event. Mahan currently ranks 54th in the FedExCup standings. This marks just the second time (back-to-back years) that he has ranked outside of the top 30 of the FedExCup standings after the 25<sup>th</sup> week of any PGA TOUR season.

Hunter Mahan has shown big improvement in his short game moving up 100 positions from last season. In the 2013-14 Tour season, Hunter Mahan ranked 148<sup>th</sup> in scrambling salvaging par 54.71% (279 of 510) of the time. However, this season Mahan ranks 48<sup>th</sup> in scrambling salvaging par 62.31% (162 of 260) on missed greens.

## Steve Stricker

2009 Crowne Plaza Invitational Champion, Steve Stricker is set to make his 9<sup>th</sup> start at this event and 3<sup>rd</sup> of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Stricker is coming off a T-38<sup>th</sup> finish in his last event THE PLAYERS.

The 2013-14 PGA TOUR season ended Steve Stricker & Phil Mickelson's streak of making it to the TOUR Championship in all 8 years of Playoff existence.

Steve is still 1 of 4 players who have made it to the TOUR Championship in 7 or more seasons (Hunter Mahan only player left to make it in all 8 years, Phil Mickelson & Jim Furyk are the other 2 with 7).

**16 Putts Over 10 Feet:** In his 2009 Crowne Plaza Invitational victory Steve Stricker converted a field leading and career best 16 putts from beyond 10 feet for the week. The only other player who has made more putts over 10 feet at the Crowne Plaza Invitational than Stricker was Tommy Gainey in 2012.

### **Brandt Snedeker**

Brandt Snedeker currently ranks 18<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 win (AT&T Pebble Beach), 4 top 10's and 7 top 25 finishes this season. In 15 events this season, Brandt Snedeker has 1 more top 10 (4) than he did in 25 events last season. A lot of Snedeker's success this season can be attributed to his play from on and around the greens. Defending Crowne Plaza Invitational Champion, Adam Scott is set to make his 4<sup>th</sup> start at this event. Adam Scott currently ranks 109<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 top 10 (T-4<sup>th</sup> WGC-Cadillac Championship) and 2 top 25 finishes this season.

Adam Scott continues to be one of the best players from Tee-to-Green on TOUR in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season.

## Patrick Reed

Patrick Reed currently ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 win (Hyundai TOC), 3 top 10's and 10 top 25's this season. Patrick Reed is set to make his 2nd appearance at Crowne Plaza Invitational.

In the last 2 TOUR seasons, Patrick read has gone from 69<sup>th</sup> in scrambling to 3<sup>rd</sup> this season. In 336 missed greens in regulation this season, Patrick Reed has managed to salvage par on 225 times.

Patrick Reed ranks 4<sup>th</sup> on TOUR in Overall Putting Average which is the average number of putts for all holes played. Patrick Reed has only needed 1,488 putts for 972 (1.531) holes played on TOUR.

## Boo Weekley

Boo Weekley picked up his 3<sup>rd</sup> career PGA TOUR victory at the 2013 Crowne Plaza Invitational with his field leading ball striking and putting performance from long distances.

On the greens, Boo ranked 33<sup>rd</sup> for Strokes Gained: Putting gaining just over ½ stroke per round with his putter at Colonial Country Club. However, when you look at his putting performance by distance you find that while he struggled from short distances he was the best in the field from long distances.

**Last from 3 to 5 Feet:** He ranked 77<sup>th</sup> (out of 77 players to make the cut) when putting from 3 to 5 feet converting 63.6% of his attempts from this distance (7 of 11).

**First from Outside 20 Feet:** Boo Weekley had a total of 21 putting attempts from outside 20 feet. For the week he converted 1 in every 3 of his attempts from outside 20 feet (7 for 21) leading the field from this distance en route to victory.

## Zach Johnson

Two-time champion of the Crowne Plaza Invitational at Colonial (2012 & 2010) Zach Johnson is set to make his 10<sup>th</sup> appearance at this event and 14<sup>th</sup> start of 2014-15 PGA TOUR Season. Zach currently ranks 65<sup>th</sup> in the race for the FedExCup on the strength of 4 top 10's and 7 top 25 finishes this season.

Colonial CC has been Zach Johnson's comfort zone, playing 18 of his last 24 rounds in the 60's and 29 of his 36 career rounds at par or better at this event.
