6:15AM Weather Update: Sun, April 19, 2015



Synopsis: A warm front, lifting north through the state, will produce showers and isolated t-storms across the area through late morning/midday. Then there may be a lull in the precipitation during the early afternoon before an upper level disturbance approaches from the west. This will provide another round of showers and t-storms late afternoon into the evening hours. A few of these storms could be strong to severe with damaging winds, hail and heavy rainfall. An approaching cold front will bring the chance for scattered showers and t-storms Monday afternoon before drier weather returns on Tuesday,

Today:

9AM:  Cloudy, 80% chance of showers and isolated t-storms.

Temp: 70F RH: 98%

Winds: SE 4-8 mph

Noon:  Cloudy, 60% chance of showers and t-storms.

Temp: 74F RH: 87%


Winds: SSE 7-12 mph

3PM:  Mostly cloudy, 50% chance of t-storms.

Temp: 78F RH: 73%

Winds: S 10-15 mph

Extended Outlook:

Mon:  Partly sunny and breezy, 40% chance of afternoon showers and thunderstorms.
Low: 66F High: 83F
Winds: SW 12-18 gusting to 25 mph
