**Synopsis:** A warm front, lifting north through the state, will produce showers and isolated t-storms across the area through late morning/midday. Then there may be a lull in the precipitation during the early afternoon before an upper level disturbance approaches from the west. This will provide another round of showers and t-storms late afternoon into the evening hours. A few of these storms could be strong to severe with damaging winds, hail and heavy rainfall. An approaching cold front will bring the chance for scattered showers and t-storms Monday afternoon before drier weather returns on Tuesday,
