

2014-15 Sanderson Farms Championship Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



The Sanderson Farms Championship returns with a new date and a new venue. The 2014-15, Sanderson Farms Championship is being held at the Country Club of Jackson for the first time in tournament history. The last time this event was played was in the 2013 PGA TOUR season (opposite The Open Championship) and won by Woody Austin.

ShotLink Keys to Victory for Woody Austin

At age 49 years, 5 months, 25 days, Woody Austin became the eighth oldest winner in TOUR history with his victory at the 2013 Sanderson Farms Championship. Austin moved to 130th in the FedExCup standings en route to picking up his 4th career victory on the PGA TOUR.

Woody Austin vs. The Field 2013 Sanderson Farms Championship

Woody Austin averaged 272.0 yards from the tee en route to victory at the Sanderson Farms Championship.

This was the 3rd shortest average from the tee by a winner on the 2013 PGA TOUR (Kevin Streelman averaged 270.8 yards when he won the Tampa Bay Championship and Zach Johnson averaged 262.1 at the BMW Championship).

Austin was particularly dialed in with his wedge game at Annandale GC. For the week, he averaged a field leading 9 feet 11 inches on approach shots from 125 to 150 yards in the fairway. This worked out to nearly 10 feet closer to the pin than the field average of 19 feet 8 inches.

David Toms

David Toms is making his 3rd start of the 2014-15 FedExCup Season. David finished T-14th in his last TOUR start at the McGladrey Classic. Toms opened with a 3 over par 73 after the first round of the McGladrey Classic making 3 bogeys and 0 birdies. This marked only his **32nd** round without a hole under par in **1,832** rounds played in his PGA TOUR career. After his opening 73, Toms made 14 birdies and 2 bogeys over the final 54 holes to finish T-14th.

Toms is making his 9th appearance at the Sanderson Farms Championship. David had his best finish at this event in 2008 finishing solo T-8th.

David Toms is known for being the most accurate drivers of the golf ball on TOUR. David lead the TOUR in driving accuracy in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season hitting 653 of 865 (75.49%) in the fairway.

The 2013-14 PGA TOUR season marked the 1st time David Toms has led in driving accuracy and hit over 75% of his fairways in his career.

David has steadily improved his play from on the greens from ranking T-118th in 2012 & 160th in 2013 in strokes gained: putting to 11th this season. In 6 rounds this season, Toms is outperforming the field by over 1 stroke with his putter.

Lucas Glover

Lucas Glover is making his 2nd appearance at the Sanderson Farms Championship. The last time he competed in this event was in 2004 finishing T-26th.

In 2012, Lucas Glover averaged 289.1 yards off the tee in measured drives. Since 2012, Glover has steadily improved his distance off the tee by over 13 yards. This season, Lucas is averaging 303.5 yards on 14 measured drives hitting 8 of 14 drives over 300 yards.

Padraig Harrington

Padraig Harrington makes his 3rd start of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season and is in search of his first top 10 finish in his last 24 PGA TOUR events. The 2013-14 PGA TOUR season marked Padraig's first season where he has played over 10 events and not had a top 10 finish in his PGA TOUR career.

Padraig is making his 1st appearance at the Sanderson Farms Championship and 233rd career start on TOUR.

Ben Martin

After firing rounds of 78-79 in his first two rounds of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Ben Martin has played 8 consecutive rounds at par or better for a total of 28 under par.

Shriners Hospitals Victory:

Ben Martin picked up his 1st career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 56th career start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open a few weeks ago.

Front 9 vs Back 9: In his victory, Ben Martin played his outward 9 holes at 3 under par compared to his inward 9 holes of 17 under for the week.

Ben Martin Front 9 vs Back 9 at TPC Summerlin

Ben Martin made 2 eagles, 16 birdies & only 3 bogeys on his back 9 at TPC Summerlin for a combined 17 under par. Martin made 8 more birdies or better, 3 less bogeys or worse, 7 strokes better tee-to-green and nearly 3 strokes better on the greens than the front 9. His 17 under par on the back 9 was 14 shots better than his score to par on the front 9.

Robert Streb

Robert Streb picked up his 1st career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 49th career start. Streb currently ranks 2nd in the race for the FedExCup, trailing leader Sang-Moon Bae by 5 points.

Final Round Strokes Gained: Putting at The McGladrey Classic: Robert Streb outperformed the field by over 3 strokes (+3.22) with his putter in the final round making 5 putts from 10 feet and over including his 33' 3" birdie on the par 3, 17th hole.

Robert Streb

In the first 3 rounds, Robert Streb outperformed the field by a combined +1.96 in strokes gained: tee-to-green. However, in the final round he outperformed the field by +2.58 strokes tee-to-green over a half a stroke better than his first 3 rounds.

Streb made a total of 6 putts from 10 feet and over in the first 3 rounds compared to 5 in the final round alone.

Contributing to Streb's success at The McGladrey Classic was his solid approach shots in the fairway. Streb ranked 3rd in fairway proximity averaging 5 feet closer than the field.

Robert Streb beat the field by +1.69 strokes per round with his putter en route to victory.

For the week, Streb outperformed the field by a total of +6.77 strokes on the greens at The McGladrey Classic.
