## ShotLink Keys to Victory for Winner Zach Johnson

Zach Johnson picked up his 11th PGA TOUR victory in his 265th start on TOUR at the Hyundai Tournament of Champions. Johnson had all facets of his game working at the Plantation Course ranking T-3rd in driving accuracy, 4th in proximity to the hole, 2nd in scrambling and 1st in one-putt percentage.

Known for his accuracy, Zach Johnson only missed 10 fairways all week ranking T-3rd in driving accuracy (50 of 60 ) hitting $83.3 \%$ of his fairways. Johnson hit 50 of 60 fairways in regulation on the Plantation course marking the 9th time in his PGA TOUR career where he has hit 50 or more fairways in a week in a 72 -hole event.

Johnson showed laser like accuracy ranking 4th in proximity to the hole averaging 35 ' 5 " for the week nearly 5 feet closer than the field average of 39 feet. In the final round Zach averaged 27 ' 9 " to the hole hitting 7 approach shots within 10 feet of the hole including his 109 yard shot on the 16th hole to within 5 feet of the flag stick extending his lead to 2 shots heading into the final 2 holes.

On The Greens: No one had more one-putts than Zach Johnson. For the week, Zach had a field leading 32 one-putts ( $44.4 \%$, 32 of 72 holes). Since 1992, Zach is 1 of 6 Hyundai TOC Champions to have 32 or more one-putts en route to victory. His 32 one-putts marked the 7 th time in his career were he has ranked 1st in this category.

## Short Game \& Putting Key on the Plantation Course at Kapalua:

10 of the last 11 Hyundai TOC winners have ranked in the top 10 for scrambling en route to their respective victories. Zach Johnson ranked 2nd in scrambling salvaging par on 13 of 16 attempts ( $81.25 \%$ ) from around the greens at the Plantation Course.

3 of the last 7 winners have led the field for putts gained en route to victory. 10 of the last 11 winners have ranked inside the top 10 for strokes gained putting en route to their victory. Zach Johnson was the only exception ranking 17th in strokes Gained: putting last season (+.017).

The Plantation Course at Kapalua has been ranked inside the top 5 for the easiest course on TOUR in 6 of the last 7 seasons.

Kapalua has some of the largest greens on the PGA TOUR and therefore easiest greens to hit on TOUR. While the course has yielded the easiest greens to hit in 10 of the last 12 years, it's ranked among the toughest in terms of getting the ball close to the pin ranking inside the top 15 toughest in 11 of the last 12 years.

## The 400 Yard Mark

Since 2003, there have been 363 drives of 400 yards or more recorded on the PGA TOUR.

213 of the 363 total 400+ yard drives recorded on the PGA TOUR in last 12 years have come from the Hyundai Tournament of Champions on the Plantation Course at Kapalua. This works out $59 \%$ of all $400+$ yard drives originating at the Plantation Course.

However last year, there were no drives recorded over 400 yards on the Plantation Course at Kapalua for the first time in the ShotLink Era. In fact, last year only 1 drive was recorded on TOUR over 400+ yards (Bubba Watson, Firestone CC (South) - 424 yards).

The par $5-18^{\text {th }}$ hole on the Plantation Course at Kapalua is responsible for $1 / 4$ of all 400 yard drives on the PGA TOUR in the last 12 years ( 92 of $363-25 \%$ ).

Most 400 Plus Drives: Dustin Johnson holds the current record for most 400+ yard drives with 12 (from 2003-2014).

Although the Plantation Course can yield some of the longest drives on TOUR, the wind can play a huge factor in dictating the driving distance.

On 2 measured drives per round for each player conducted on holes \#3 and \#15 at the Plantation Course the longest average drives was in 2002 where players averaged nearly 285 yards off the tee.

However, 2013 the field average in driving distance was the lowest since 2002 with a distance of 254.16 yards.

In 2014, the 2 measured driving distance holes (\#3 and \#15) averaged 272.9 yards. 2014 marked the longest averaged measured drives since 2005 when the 2 holes averaged 276.42 yards.

Sang-Moon Bae picked up his $2^{\text {nd }}$ career victory on the PGA TOUR in his $80^{\text {th }}$ career start. Bae currently ranks 2nd in the race for the FedExCup.

Sang-Moon Bae beat the field by over 3 strokes per round with his tee-to-green game en route to victory. He was also nearly three-quarters of a stroke per round better than the next best player from tee-to-green.

Bae holed out from around the green on 3 separate occasions en route to victory. However, he did not manage to make a putt from outside of 15 feet on the greens for the entire week.

Keys to Victory: Valero Texas Open Steven was 26 of 36 (72.22\%) in greens in regulation ranking T-3rd in the field through 2 rounds. However in rounds 3 \& 4, Bowditch only managed to hit 18 of 36 (50\%) greens in regulation on the weekend marking just the T-14th player to hit 18 or fewer greens in regulation and go onto victory (4 round events since 1983).

## Bowditch Standout Stat:

Steven Bowditch has made huge strides in his play from around the greens. In the 2013/14 PGA TOUR season, Bowditch went 348 of 613 ( $56.77 \%$ ) from around the greens ranking 120th on TOUR. However, this season Bowditch ranks 6th in scrambling salvaging par on 51 of 67 ( $76.12 \%$ ) missed greens.

Angel Cabrera had every facet of his game in sync en route to victory. He ranked $2^{\text {nd }}$ in total driving, $4^{\text {th }}$ for driving accuracy, $1^{\text {st }}$ for ball striking, hit a field leading $79 \%$ of his greens in regulation, ranked $\mathrm{T}-6^{\text {th }}$ for proximity to the hole and $5^{\text {th }}$ on the greens for strokes gained: putting.

Career Putting Week: Cabrera's 15 putts made from outside 10 feet was both the best by any player in the field and a new career best for Cabrera on the PGA TOUR. His previous best of 12 putts made over 10 feet came during the 2007 WGCCadillac Championship.

Brendon Todd hit 40 of 56 (71\%) of his fairways from the tee leading the field for driving accuracy. Brendon is the first winner on TOUR to lead the field for driving accuracy since Louis Oosthuizen led the field en route to victory at the 2010 Open
Championship (a span of 162 PGA TOUR victories without a player leading the field for driving accuracy).

Brendon ranked T-55 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ for greens in regulation (59\%) on TPC Four Seasons marking the lowest G.I.R. rank by a winner since Ken Duke ranked $62^{\text {nd }}$ in the field for greens in regulation en route to victory at the 2013 Travelers Championship.

Keys to Victory (3): 2013/14 Northern Trust Open Watson finished off the week with back-to-back bogey-free rounds of 64 for a final 36 -hole total of 128. Watson's final 36hole total of 128 marked both a career low and a tournament record at the Northern Trust Open. The previous low round 3 \& 4 total at the Northern Trust Open was 129 by Doug Tewell at the 1986 NTO.

Bogey-Free on the Weekend: Bubba Watson was the only player in the field to go bogey-free in the final 2 rounds at the Northern Trust Open. Watson becomes the first winner (since 1983 - when hole by hole records began) at the Northern Trust Open to go bogey-free in rounds $3 \& 4$ and just the $2^{\text {nd }}$ player at this event to accomplish this feat since Ben Crenshaw went bogey-free in rounds $3 \& 4$ en route to his runner-up finish at the 1987 Northern Trust Open.

In the opening 2 rounds, Watson went 7 for 13 when scrambling from around the greens. Watson's average scrambling chip shot ended $13^{\prime} 10$ " from the pin. In the final 2 rounds, he went a perfect 8 for 8 from around the greens averaging just 3 ' 6 " to the pin on his 8 chip shots from off the green.
