ShotLink Keys to Victory for Hideki Matsuyama

Hideki Matsuyama won on the first playoff hole defeating Kevin Na. Matsuyama birdied his 72nd hole in regulation to get into the playoff making it 4 consecutive rounds with a birdie on the 18th hole. Since 1983, no player has birdied the 18th hole in every round of the Memorial Tournament (Matsuyama was the first).

Matsuyama got it done with his exceptional tee to green play at the Memorial Tournament ranking T-11th in Driving Accuracy, T-22nd in Greens in Regulation, 1st in Proximity to the Hole and 2nd in Birdie Average.

Hideki's iron play was spectacular averaging 25 feet to the flagstick on approach shots. Matsuyama lead the field in Proximity to the Hole averaging 7'6" inches closer than the field average of 32'6". Since 2003, Matsuyama is only the 12th winner to average 25 feet or less on approach shots en route to victory on the PGA TOUR.

Hideki Matsuyama ranked 46th in Strokes Gained: Putting (among players to make the cut) losing -.026 of a stroke per round. Matsuyama was only the 22nd player of 414 winners on TOUR (Since 2004, inception of SG: Putting) to lose strokes on the greens and go onto victory.

Hideki Matsuyama ranked T-11th for Driving Accuracy and T-22nd in Greens in Regulation at Muirfield Village for the week. No one hit it closer to the hole than Hideki, ranking 1st in the field for Proximity to the Hole and Proximity to the Hole from the Fairway. He averaged over 7 feet closer to the pin than the field in both categories.

Jim Furyk led the field in Scrambling at the 2015 the Memorial Tournament. Furyk was 81.48% from around the greens at Muirfield Village salvaging par on 22 of 27 missed greens in regulation.

Steve Stricker

48 year old Steve Stricker has made 444 career starts on the PGA TOUR. He's accumulated 12 wins, 103 top tens, and 193 top twenty-five finishes. In his 444 career starts, he's missed 109 cuts. However, more recently he's missed just 2 cuts in the last 6 years on the PGA TOUR.

2 Missed Cuts in last 6 Years: In Stricker's first 20 years on PGA TOUR he missed 107 total cuts in 359 starts. This works out to missing the cut once every 3.3 starts.

Stricker has had a perfect Cuts Made record in 4 of his last 6 seasons on the PGA TOUR (2010, 2011, 2013, & 2014) missing the cut once every 42.5 starts.

Steve Stricker - Front 9 vs. Back 9 2011 Memorial Tournament

2011 Memorial Tournament champion Steve Stricker played the first 9 holes of Muirfield Village at 20 under par for the week (lowest total RTP score on the front 9 at Memorial since 1983).

Stricker's 20 under par was 7 shots better than the next best player (Kuchar – 13 under) and 17 shots better than the field RTP average on the front 9 (-3.01).

Matt Kuchar

Matt Kuchar has made 134 starts on the PGA TOUR since the start of the 2010 season. Over this time frame he's accumulated a TOUR leading 29 top 5's, 51 top 10's and 92 top 25's (all most of any player on TOUR). Much of Kuchar's success is related to getting off to a good start each week. In fact, he's the only player who has ranked inside the top 15 for scoring average before the cut in each of the last 6 years on the PGA TOUR.

Best from the Bunkers at Muirfield Village: Matt Kuchar has been in 55 greenside bunkers at Muirfield Village since 2007 and managed to get up and down an impressive 80% of the time (44 saves). The next closest player in terms of save percentage is Nick O'Hearn at 63% from the greenside bunkers since 2007.

Hideki Matsuyama

Hideki Matsuyama currently ranks 12th in the FedExCup standings having carded 7 top-10 finishes in 15 starts on TOUR this season. Only Jordan Spieth has more top 10 finishes this season and Matsuyama (Speith has 8). Matsuyama and Sangmoon Bae are the only 2 players who have ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup in all 27 weeks this season.

Only Rory McIlroy has performed better from tee-to-green than Hideki Matsuyama on the PGA TOUR this season.

Hideki Matsuyama ranks 131st on the PGA TOUR for Strokes Gained: Putting losing -0.152 strokes per round with his putter this season. However, his putting performance from short vs. long distances varies greatly.

Hideki currently has the most eagles on the PGA TOUR this season (13). 2 of his 13 eagles have come on par 4's with the remaining 11 coming on par 5's.

Rickie Fowler

Rickie Fowler is making his first PGA TOUR start since his PLAYERS victory and is also coming off a T-30th finish last week at the Dubai Duty Free Irish Open.

Keys to Victory at PLAYERS: Rickie Fowler moved from 67th to 10th in the FedExCup standings with his 2nd career victory on the PGA TOUR (currently 15th in the standings entering this week). Fowler finished his final round playing holes 15-18 in 11 strokes including his birdie “3” on the final hole of regulation.

Birdie on 72nd Hole: In his career Fowler played 1,170 different holes (in stroke-play events) on the PGA TOUR. He has played no other hole more over par than the 18th hole at TPC Sawgrass.

Standing on the tee of his 72nd hole in regulation, Fowler was 13 over par in 16 rounds on the 18th hole of the PLAYERS Stadium course. In his 16 rounds he had made 8 pars, 3 bogeys and 5 double bogeys. The 18th hole was the only hole at the time that Fowler was yet to make a birdie at TPC Sawgrass.

18th Hole Driving Distance Average (in regulation): Rickie Fowler averaged 324 yards on the 18th hole marking the longest average driving distance on the 18th hole (TPC Sawgrass, players playing all 4 rounds) since 2003.

Fowler's performance on the green in the final round pales in comparison to his first 3 rounds. He outperformed himself by nearly 5 shots in Strokes Gained: Putting and made over 40 feet more of putts compared to his average in the first 3 rounds.

Phil Mickelson

Phil Mickelson has 2 top 4 finishes in his last 3 starts on the PGA TOUR (T2 at the Masters and T-4 at Wells Fargo). At this point last season, Mickelson was still in search of his first top-10 finish of the season in his 12 starts ranking 98th in the FedExCup standings.

Bill Haas

Bill Haas is set to make his 10th appearance at the Memorial Tournament and 14th of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Haas currently ranks 17th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 win (CareerBuilder Challenge), 3 top 10's and 7 top 25 finishes this season.

Bill Haas is coming off back-to-back top 10 finishes at this event (2013, T-4th & 2014, T-8th). In his previous 7 starts at the Memorial Tournament, Haas didn't have a finish inside of the top 30. Bill Haas has the most rounds of 68 or better at Muirfield Village the last 2 years with 4 (next best player 2 rounds).

Jordan Spieth is set to make his 74th start on TOUR and 16th of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season.

Jordan Spieth played Jekyll and Hyde when referencing his game Tee-to-Green and On the Greens at last week's AT&T Byron Nelson (72 players made the cut). Spieth continues to lead the TOUR for putts / round despite his poor putting performance last week.
