Weather Forecast for St Andrews

HAZARDS: Nil.

HEADLINE: Soon clouding over this morning with some spots of rain. Further outbreaks of rain during the afternoon with some moderate spells. Brightening up during the evening. SE winds.

PERIOD	WEATHER	WIND
0600 to 1200	Dry and bright to start. Cloud amounts increasing during the morning with some patchy rain.	VRB 0-5mph becoming SE 5 to 10mph, increasing 10-15mph.
1200 to 1800	A cloudy afternoon with some outbreaks of rain, much of it light but there will be some moderate bursts mid-afternoon, 1-4mm. Rain becoming light and easing by evening. Another cool feel to the afternoon.	SE 10-15mph, although 15-20mph mid-afternoon, with gusts 25mph possible for a time.
1800 to 2400	Brightening up with some late evening brightness/clear spells and the odd shower.	SE 10-15mph soon becoming SW 10-15mph during the evening after rain clears.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURE 12 CELSIUS
