

2015 WGC-Cadillac Championship Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



ShotLink Keys to Victory for Patrick Reed

At 23 years old, Patrick Reed picked up his 3rd career victory at the 2014 WGC-Cadillac Championship in his 51st start on TOUR. Reed is 1 of just 4 players currently under 25 on the PGA TOUR with multiple victories (McIlroy, English, Henley are the other 3). Reed became the youngest winner of a World Golf Championships event since their inception back in 1999.

Reed ranked inside the top 10 in a number of key stats en route to his victory on Trump National Doral. He ranked 4th in driving distance, 1st for approach shots from 175-200 yards, 8th in sand saves, 6th for scrambling, and 9th for strokes gained – putting.

Reed ranked T-52nd for fairways hit and T-28th for greens in regulation for the week. That being said, he needed to rely heavily on his short game.

He missed 30 greens for the week and found 14 greenside bunkers.

From the sand he went 10 for 14 (71% - 8th) and successfully salvaged par or better on 20 of 30 missed greens (67% - 6th)

Patrick Reed is the first champion at Trump National Doral to hit fewer than 25 fairways and fewer than 45 greens en route to victory (since 1983 when records have been kept).

From 2003 to 2006, the PGA TOUR had a regular full field event last known as the Ford Championship at Doral. Starting in 2007 Trump National hosted the WGC-Cadillac Championship.

Since 2003, The Blue Monster at Trump National Doral has been one of the most penalizing courses on TOUR. Last season was the first season of the redesigned Blue Monster which resulted in the most balls in the water 318 totaling 98 more than the next highest year 2004 with 220.

The Blue Monster at Trump National Doral had the most balls in the water of any course on TOUR with 318 in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.

Broadcast Window Notes 2015 WGC-Cadillac Championship *(featured groups)*

Rory McIlroy

McIlroy is set to make his 23rd start in a World Golf Championships event this week. Rory won his last WGC event at the Bridgestone Invitational last August.

This week will mark McIlroy's 7th start in the WGC-Cadillac Championship; last year he recorded a T-25th place finish at Trump National Doral. McIlroy has top-25 finishes in 6 of his 7 starts at this event.

In the last 4 years at the WGC-Cadillac Championship, no one has been better on the par 5's than Rory McIlroy.

Since 2011, Rory has played 16 rounds at the WGC-Cadillac Championship playing each 5 par 16 times for a total of 64 par 5's played during this timeframe. During this stretch he is 32 under par with 5 eagles, 28 birdies, 27 pars 2 bogeys and 2 double bogeys (both in 2014 in round 3 on holes 8 & 10).

2013-14 Approach the Green Analysis

Rory McIlroy's greens in regulation numbers improved over the past 3 years on the PGA TOUR. Last season marked the first time in Rory's career where he ranked inside the top 10 for greens in regulation for a single season.

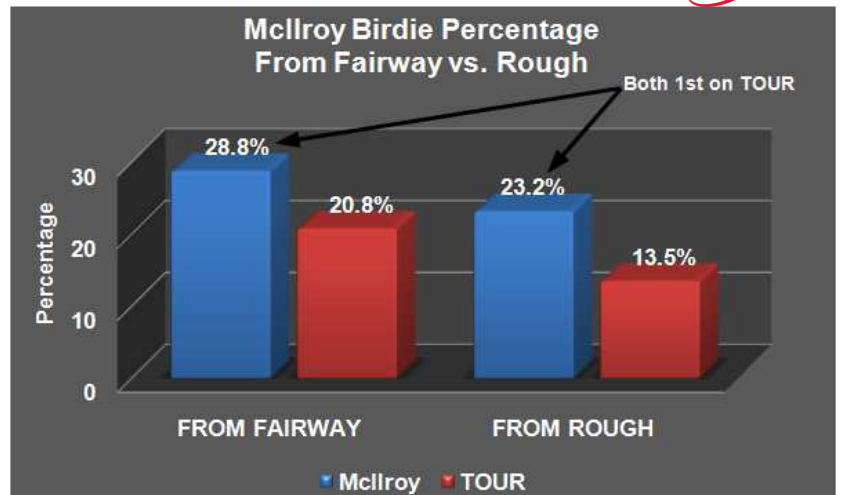

1st from both Fairway & Rough: Rory McIlroy ranked 1st on TOUR in 2013-14 for birdie or better percentage from both the rough and the fairway becoming the first player in the ShotLink Era to accomplish this feat.

From the fairway, Rory made birdie or better nearly 29% of the time. From the rough, he made birdie or better over 23% of the time during the 2013-14 season.



2013-14 Around the Green Analysis

During the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Rory McIlroy was the 3rd best player on TOUR when scrambling from the rough.

Rory McIlroy missed 100 greens in regulation that found greenside rough during his 2013-14 season. He successfully salvaged par or better 66 times ranking 3rd on TOUR when scrambling from the rough.

Rory McIlroy made 22 of 188 attempts from outside 25 feet during the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. His 11.7% make percentage marks the highest single season performance recorded in the ShotLink Era (since 2003).

Adam Scott

Adam Scott is set to make his 14th career start at the WGC-Cadillac Championship this week. In his previous 13 starts he's carded 1 runner-up (2006), 4 top tens, and 6 top twenty-five finishes. More recently, he's finished inside the top 25 in each of his last 4 starts at this event (T25 2014, T3 2013, T13 in 2012 & T6 in 2011).

In 2010, Adam Scott ranked 186th on TOUR in strokes gained: putting losing nearly 3 quarters of a stroke to the field per round with his putter.

Since 2010, Adam has been steadily improving on the greens ranking 27th last season in strokes gained: putting outperforming the TOUR by over a half a shot per round and +1.277 strokes compared to the 2010 PGA TOUR season.

Henrik Stenson

Henrik Stenson is set to make his 8th appearance at the WGC-Cadillac Championship. Stenson has 1 top 10 and 4 top 25 finishes in his 7 starts at this event.

Henrik Stenson led the TOUR in greens in regulation in the 2013 PGA TOUR season and ranked 8th in the 2013-14 TOUR season.

Martin Kaymer

Martin Kaymer is set to make his 3rd appearance of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season and 8th at the WGC-Cadillac Championship. Martin is coming off a T-44th place finish at last weeks The Honda Classic and currently ranks 139th in the FedExCup standings.

Martin Kaymer is yet to break par in his last 6 rounds and 11 of his last 16 on the Blue Monster at Trump National Doral. However, in his last World Golf Championships event he finished T-6th at the WGC-HSBC Champions.

Rickie Fowler

Rickie Fowler is in search for his 2nd top 10 finish this season. His first came at the first WGC event this season at the WGC-HSBC Champions.

Despite playing fewer holes last year, Jason Day had just 15 total 3-putts in 864 stroke play holes ranking 2nd on TOUR in this category.

His 58 holes per 3-putt marked a career best on the PGA TOUR and was a vast improvement over his 2013 performance of one 3-putt every 37 holes played.

Jason Day Farmers Insurance Open Win:

Jason Day picked up his 3rd victory in his 154th career start on the PGA TOUR. Day was the 7th PGA TOUR winner in his 20's this season.

Jason Day led the field in Driving Distance averaging 308.9 yards off the tee at the Farmers Insurance Open. His average of 308.9 yards was 20 yards farther than the field average of 288.6 yards. This marked the 5th time Jason Day has led the field in driving distance (in an event) and first time he has led the field in driving distance and won.

Justin Rose

2012 WGC-Cadillac Championship winner, Justin Rose is making his 9th appearance at this event. Justin has never finished worse than T-46th at this event (2002, His first appearance).

In his victory in 2012, he ranked 11th for total driving, T-9th for ball striking, T-17th for greens in regulation, T-5th for proximity to the hole and 6th for scrambling from around the greens. For the week, Rose converted 8 more birdies than average player in the field (Rose with a field leading 23 birdies; field avg: 15).

In the 2013 PGA TOUR season, Justin Rose made a total of 3 eagles making 1 eagle per 360 holes played on TOUR. However, in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season Rose made a total of 12 eagles making 1 eagle in every 102 holes played on TOUR.

Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green: Known as one of the best ball strikers on TOUR. Justin Rose has ranked 1st (2013 season) and 4th (2013-14 season) in strokes gained: tee-to-green in the last 2 PGA TOUR seasons. Sergio Garcia

Sergio Garcia is set to make his 5th appearance of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Garcia currently ranks 34th in the FEC standings on the strength of 2 top 10 finishes.

Since the inception of strokes gained-putting in 2004, Sergio Garcia has been struggling on the greens. From 2004 until 2011, Sergio only gained strokes to the field in one season (2007). During this time frame Sergio lost a total of **-62.50** strokes to the field with his putter.

Matt Kuchar is set to make his 6th WGC-Cadillac Championship appearance. His best finish at this event came in 2010 finishing T-3rd.

Jordan Spieth ranked 2nd in total driving (8th in Driving Distance & T-12th in Driving Accuracy) and 1st in rough proximity en route to his T-4th place finish at the Northern Trust open.

Bubba Watson

Winner of the first WGC event of the year the WGC-HSBC Champions, Bubba Watson currently ranks 3rd in the FedExCup standings entering this week. In 4 events in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Watson is yet to finish outside of the top 15.

Bubba Watson currently ranks 6th in strokes gained: tee-to-green and 25th in strokes gained: putting outperforming the field by a total of +1.898. His strokes gained: total of +1.898 leads the TOUR this season.

Jim Furyk

Jim Furyk carded his 301st top twenty-five finish in his last event at the Northern Trust Open finishing T-14th. The total number is impressive as is but is even more impressive when you compare it to his 527 career starts on TOUR (works out to 57% top twenty-five finish rate).

More recently, Jim Furyk now has finished inside the top twenty five in his last 12 consecutive starts on TOUR dating back to his T-19th finish at the 2013-14 Memorial Tournament. He has just 1 finish outside the top 25 in his last 18 starts on the PGA TOUR (T51 at the 2013-14 Crowne Plaza).
