## ShotLink Keys to Victory for Brandt Snedeker

Career Scrambling Week: Brandt Snedeker successfully salvaged par or better on 12 of 13 missed greens ( $92 \%$ ) leading the field for scrambling for the $5^{\text {th }}$ time in his PGA TOUR career. His $92.31 \%$ success rate from around the greens was a career high for Snedeker in a PGA TOUR event.

One Bogey all Week: The 64 players who played all 4 rounds at the 2015 AT\&T Pebble Beach averaged 8 over par holes per player (8.02) for the week. There were 21 players with 10 or more bogeys +59 players with 5 or more bogeys + , and 63 players with 3 or more bogeys+ for the week. Snedeker had just one bogey over the course of the week leading the field for lowest bogey average.

## Dustin Johnson

Back to Back Champion in 2009 \& 2010, Dustin Johnson is set to make his $9^{\text {th }}$ start at Pebble Beach. In his first four events this season, Dustin hasn't finished outside of T-18 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ at the Farmers Insurance Open (shot 80 in final round).

Since his Rookie year on TOUR in 2008, only 1 other player has more total eagles on TOUR than Dustin Johnson. His total of 93 eagles is 9 less than Bubba Watson and 11 more than the next best player Charles Howell III with 82.

## Justin Rose

Justin Rose is set to make his 1st appearance at the AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and $3^{\text {rd }}$ start of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season. In his 2 starts this season, Rose finished T-6 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ at the Frys.com Open and missed the cut two weeks ago at the Farmers Insurance Open.

FedExCup: Justin Rose is 1 of 3 Players to make it to the TOUR Championship in each of the last 6 seasons and is the only player to finish $15^{\text {th }}$ or better in this timeframe.

Best from Tee-to-Green Last 6 Years: No one has been better on the PGA TOUR from tee-to-green in the last 6 years than Justin Rose (min of 300 rds ). On average, Rose outperforms the field by +1.33 strokes per round from tee-to-green (best on TOUR).

Rose has ranked inside the top 25 for Strokes Gained: Tee-toGreen in each of the last 6 years on the PGA TOUR.

Best on TOUR from $\mathbf{1 7 5}$ to $\mathbf{2 0 0}$ Yards \& $\mathbf{7 5}$ to $\mathbf{1 0 0}$ Yards: In addition to being the best mid-long iron player on TOUR last season, Rose has drastically improved his wedge game the last 4 years on TOUR working his way up from T-105 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ in 2012 to $\mathrm{T}-1^{\text {st }}$ this past season from 75 to 100 yards.

Justin Rose has ranked inside the top 20 for sand saves in each year on TOUR since the start of the 2010 PGA TOUR season. Over this time frame he is 415 of 696 from greenside bunkers (59.6\%).

## Jordan Spieth

The defending FedExCup Champion currently ranks $13^{\text {th }}$ in the standings on the strength of a T-7 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ place finish at the WGC-HSBC Champions and a win at the Hyundai TOC. Jordan Spieth is set to make his $3^{\text {rd }}$ start of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season and $4^{\text {th }}$ appearance at the AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. Spieth has back to back top 10 finishes at this event the last 2 seasons and three straight top 25 's.

Jordan Spieth has been on a rampage since his first full season on TOUR. In 75 starts, Spieth has collected 7 victories ( $9.3 \%$ ), 23 top 5's 29.3\%), 34 top 10's ( $44 \%$ ) \& 52 top 25 ( $66.7 \%$ ) finishes. In this timeframe he is a collective 395 under par.

Spieth is converting birdie or better on $48.08 \%$ of his greens hit in regulation this season.

In 104 greens hit in regulation, Jordan has made birdie or better 50 times. His $48 \%$ conversion percentage is $18 \%$ better than the TOUR average of 30.25\%.

## Brandt Snedeker

2013 \& 2015 AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am champion, Brandt Snedeker is set to make his $9^{\text {th }}$ start at this event. Coming off his $8^{\text {th }}$ PGA TOUR victory at the Farmers Insurance Open and $7^{\text {th }}$ since the start of the 2011 PGA TOUR season. Brandt Snedeker has the T-3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ most wins of any player in this timeframe.

Brandt Snedeker is coming off a win at the Farmers Insurance Open and a T-33 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ place finish at the Waste Management Phoenix Open in his last two weeks on TOUR. Snedeker stayed in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ position of the FedExCup standings trailing Kevin Kisner by just 24 points.

Snedeker carded 4 birdies and 1 bogey in the final round where the field was averaging nearly 6 bogeys for the round. His 69 was nearly 9 shots $(+8.90)$ better than the field average in the final round.

## Best Rounds by Winners during the Toughest Rounds

In the past 20 years there have been 22 rounds on the PGA TOUR (including majors) where the scoring average was 5 or more strokes over par. 19 of these 22 rounds have been in major championships. Torrey Pines (South) in the final round was just the $3^{\text {rd }}$ non-major round with a scoring average of 5 or more strokes over par in the last 20 years on TOUR.

The 3 non-major rounds with field averages of $5+$ strokes include the following: $3^{\text {rd }}$ round of the 1999 AT\&T Pebble Beach (+7.4), final round of the 2016 Farmers Insurance Open (+5.9), and the final round of the 1999 Shriners Hospitals (+5.56).

Brandt Snedeker beat the field by +8.90 strokes in the final round of the 2016 Farmers Insurance Open marking the most shots better than the field by a winner when the field average is 5 or more strokes over par in the last 20 years on the PGA TOUR.

2014 AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am champion, Jimmy Walker is set to make his $9^{\text {th }}$ start at this event. Walker is coming off his $37^{\text {th }}$ career top 10 finish at the Farmers Insurance Open a couple weeks ago finishing T-4 ${ }^{\text {th }}$.

## Bubba Watson

Bubba Watson is set to make his $3^{\text {rd }}$ start at the AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. In his first 2 starts he is yet to crack the top 25 finishing $\mathrm{T}-44^{\text {th }}$ in 2007 \& missing the cut in 2006. Bubba is coming off a T-14 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ place finish at the Waste Management Phoenix Open closing with a final round 5 under par 66 which moved him from T-39 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ to a T-14 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ finish. Bubba finished his round Sunday hitting his last 11 consecutive Greens in Regulation.

Bubba had two completely different games from tee-to-green compared to on the greens. Bubba ranked $3^{\text {rd }}$ in the field for Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green outperforming the field by +2.71 strokes per round. However what he gained tee-togreen was almost completely lost on the greens. ## Jason Dufner

Jason Dufner is set to make his $8^{\text {th }}$ start of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season and $7^{\text {th }}$ appearance at the AT\&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. Dufner is coming off a missed cut at the Waste Management Phoenix Open and currently ranks $9^{\text {th }}$ in the FedExCup standings. Dufner collected his $4^{\text {th }}$ PGA TOUR victory a few weeks ago at the CareerBuilder Challenge.

Made Birdie on 50\% of Par 4's \& 5's: Jason Dufner converted 28 total birdies on 56 par 4's and par 5's played en route to victory. He was the only player to crack the $50 \%$ in the field. This is impressive considering that the average player made birdie on $32 \%$ of the par 4's and 5's for the week.

Jason Dufner is just the $3^{\text {rd }}$ winner on the PGA TOUR since 1980 to make birdie or better on at least half of the par 4's and par 5's en route to victory.
