At 22 years old, Jordan Spieth joins Rory McIlroy and Tiger Woods as the only players to win PGA TOUR Player of the Year while in their 20's.

Spieth was the youngest player to win 5 times in a season since Horton Smith in 1929. He was also the youngest player to win both the TOUR

Championship and the FedExCup.


In 88 total rounds last season, Jordan Spieth finished 1st or 2nd on the leader board a TOUR leading 24 times (27%). This works out to 1 in every 4 rounds where Spieth was either 1st or 2nd on the leaderboard last season.

**Byron Nelson Award Winner:** Jordan Spieth finished his season with the lowest adjusted scoring average on the PGA TOUR (68.938) and in turn won the Byron Nelson Award for the first time in his career on the PGA TOUR.

83% of his rounds at Par or Better: Jordan Spieth played 83% of his rounds at par or better last season. This works out to 73 of 88 total rounds at par or better. Spieth played his last 19 final rounds of the season at par or better. In fact, he did not have an over par final round during the 2015 calendar year on the PGA TOUR.

**Spieth vs. the Next Best:** When compared to the next best player(s) on TOUR last season, Jordan Spieth had 3 more top 3's, 3 more top 5's and 4 more top-10 finishes than the next best player(s) on TOUR.

**Single Season Record:** Jordan Spieth set a new PGA TOUR record (since 2003) for highest percentage of putts made from 15 to 25 feet in a single season (27.2%).

2014 FedExCup champion Billy Horschel carded 2 wins (BMW Championship and TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola, 1 runner-up finish, 5 top ten and 12 top twenty-five finishes in his 27 starts this year.

2014 TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola, winner Billy Horschel had all facets of his game working ranking 2<sup>nd</sup> in strokes gained: tee-to-green, 1st in greens in regulation, T-5 in proximity to the hole, T-8 in scrambling and 6<sup>th</sup> in strokes gained: putting. In strokes gained: tee-to-green, Horschel outperformed the field by +2.19 strokes per round and in strokes gained putting: he outperformed the field by +3.26 (+.815 per round) total strokes with his putter.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> hole at East Lake, Horschel hit his tee shot into the right trees and was forced to punch out and have an approach from 94 yards. His approach from 94 yards ended up 30' 9" from the hole for par.

For the season he made a combined 18 putts from over 20 feet in 391 attempts (4.6%). However, in the prior 2 weeks he made a total of 13 of 71 (18.3%).

Horschel went on to make the clutch par save and go onto par the 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> holes to win the TOUR Championship and FedExCup.

2013 FedExCup champion Henrik Stenson carded 2 wins (Deutsche Bank Championship &TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola, 3 runner-up finishes, 8 top ten's and 10 top twenty-five finishes in his 18 starts last year.

2013 TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola winner Henrik Stenson ranked T-1<sup>st</sup> in greens in regulation for the week hitting his mark 77.78% (56 of 72) of the time. This marked the 3<sup>rd</sup> time out of the 4 FedExCup Playoff events were he led the field in this category. For the 2013 FEC Playoffs, Stenson hit 218 of 288 (75.69%) greens in regulation ranking 1<sup>st</sup> among players who played in all 4 Playoff events.

Henrik Stenson played the front 9 at East Lake Golf Club at an average of 31.50, 14 under par for the week. His 14 under relative to par score was 8 shots better than the next best player and over 3 strokes better than the field average of 34.66 per round.

2012 TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola winner Brandt Snedeker was solid tee-to-green ranking 8th in total driving, T5th for ball striking and 2nd for strokes gained – putting. On the greens he outperformed the field by over 6 strokes with the putter (+6.524) ranking 2nd in strokes gained – putting.

On the 17th hole, Snedeker hit his 2nd shot onto the fringe 28'6" from the cup. Brandt relied on his short game in the final round only hitting 9 of 18 greens in regulation. Snedeker managed to chip in for birdie to take a 4 shot lead going into the 72nd hole; where he ended up winning by three.

In the final round, Snedeker was only the 5<sup>th</sup> player to birdie the 17th hole due to the tough pin placement (front left) over a bunker with water left.

2011 FedExCup champion **Bill Haas** carded 1 win (TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola, 2 runner-up finishes, 7 top tens and 12 top twenty-five finishes in his 26 starts last year.

2011 TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola winner Bill Haas was solid tee-to-green ranking 2nd in total driving, 5th for ball striking and 1st for strokes gained – putting. On the greens he outperformed the field by over 8 strokes with the putter (+8.143) leading the field for strokes gained – putting.

On the 2nd playoff hole (17), Haas hit his 2nd shot into the greenside water to the left of the 17th green and managed to successfully get the ball up and down to force another hole.

For the week, 5 players hit their 2nd shots in the water on the 17th hole in regulation play and all made bogey or worse. Haas is the only player since 2004 to successfully salvage par or better after hitting his 2nd shot in the water on the 17th hole at East Lake GC.

In the final round, Snedeker was only the 5<sup>th</sup> player to birdie the 17th hole due to the tough pin placement (front left) over a bunker with water left.

#### Greenside Bunker Performance at East Lake GC - 2010 FedExCup Champion

At the 2010 TOUR Championship presented by Coca-Cola, **Jim Furyk** was faced with an 18 yard bunker shot on the 72<sup>nd</sup> hole. In 2010, the TOUR average for sand saves from 10 to 20 yards was 54%. The average bunker shot on TOUR lands 9 feet 6 inches from the hole. Entering the week, Furyk ranked 134<sup>th</sup> on TOUR for sand saves from 10 to 20 yards with a success rate of just 49%. Jim went on to hit his bunker shot 2 feet 5 inches from the hole and clinch trophies for both the TOUR Championship and the 2010 FedExCup.

If he had missed the 2 foot 5 inch putt and gone on to lose in a playoff to Luke Donald, **Furyk** would have ended up seventh in the final FedExCup standings. The bonus money for seventh pays \$700,000 -- so it would be fair to say that the final putt was potentially worth \$9.3 million. Jim's perfect 9 for 9 was just 2 off his career high on the PGA TOUR for sand saves in an event (he went 11 for 11 at the '09 WGC-CA). No player has hit more bunkers and kept a perfect save record in the history of the TOUR Championship at East Lake.

#### Water Shot on 17th Hole - 2nd playoff hole - 2011 FedExCup Champion

On the 2nd playoff hole (17), **Bill Haas** hit his 2nd shot into the greenside water to the left of the 17th green and managed to successfully get the ball up and down to force another hole. For the week, 5 players hit their 2nd shots in the water on the 17th hole in regulation play and all made bogey or worse. Haas is the only player since 2004 to successfully salvage par or better after hitting his 2nd shot in the water on the 17th hole at East Lake GC.
