Bill Haas, Jordan Spieth, Jimmy Walker share 36-hole lead at Hero World Challenge

At 11-under 133, Bill Haas, Jordan Spieth and Jimmy Walker share the lead at the midway point of the 2015 Hero World Challenge.

Earlier this year, Spieth capped off the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season by winning the FedExCup, with victories coming at the Valspar Championship, Masters Tournament, U.S. Open, John Deere Classic and TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola.

Spieth won the 2014 Hero World Challenge by a record 10 strokes over Henrik Stenson, becoming the first player to win the event in wire-to-wire fashion. His tournament-record 26-under 262 winning score shattered the previous record of 22-under 266 set by Tiger Woods in 2007. Spieth is attempting to join Woods (2006-07) as the only players to win the Hero World Challenge in back-to-back seasons.

Second-Round Leader Results at the Hero World Challenge

In 2014, eventual champion Jordan Spieth, at 11-under-par 133, led by two strokes over Henrik Stenson.

In the 16 previous playings of the Hero World Challenge, the second-round leader/co-leader has gone on to win seven times. Tiger Woods carried the second-round lead/co-lead to victory in 2004, 2006, 2007 and 2011, with Tom Lehman doing so in 1999, Graeme McDowell in 2012 and Jordan Spieth in 2014.

The largest second-round lead at the Hero World Challenge is four strokes, posted by Tiger Woods in 2007 and 2010.
