ShotLink Keys to Victory for Patrick Reed

Patrick Reed picked up his 4th career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 72nd career start earning 500 FedExCup points at the 2015 Hyundai TOC.

Eagle on 16th Hole: Reed holed an 80 yard wedge shot in the final round on the 16th hole to go from 19 under to 21 under par. His 80 yard hole out was his 3rd longest hole out in his PGA TOUR career (141 yards 2013 The Greenbrier Classic 2nd round, 103 yards 2014 WGC-Bridgestone Invitational 4th round).

Last 4 Hyundai TOC Champions Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green Stats

Patrick Reed ranked 1st in Strokes Gained: tee-to-green, marking the 4th straight winner of the Hyundai TOC to accomplish this feat. Reed outperformed the field by an average of +1.988 strokes per round in Strokes Gained: tee-to-green.

Short Game & Putting Key on the Plantation Course at Kapalua:

11 of the last 12 Hyundai TOC winners have ranked in the top 10 for scrambling en route to their respective victories. Patrick Reed ranked 2nd in scrambling salvaging par on 12 of 14 attempts (85.71%) from around the greens at the Plantation Course.

3 of the last 8 winners have led the field for putts gained en route to victory. 10 of the last 12 winners have ranked inside the top 10 for strokes gained putting en route to their victory. Patrick Reed (2015) & Zach Johnson (2014) were the only exceptions ranking 16th & 17th in strokes Gained: putting last 2 seasons.

The Plantation Course at Kapalua has been ranked inside the top 5 for the easiest course on TOUR in 7 of the last 8 seasons.

Kapalua has some of the largest greens on the PGA TOUR and therefore are the easiest greens to hit on TOUR. While the course has yielded the easiest greens to hit in 11 of the last 13 years, it's ranked among the toughest in terms of getting the ball close to the pin ranking inside the top 15 toughest in 12 of the last 13 years.

The 400 Yard Mark

Since 2003, there have been 380 drives of 400 yards or more recorded on the PGA TOUR.

223 of the 380 total 400+ yard drives recorded on the PGA TOUR in last 13 years have come from the Hyundai Tournament of Champions on the Plantation Course at Kapalua. This works out 59% of all 400+ yard drives originating at the Plantation Course.

However in 2014, there were no drives recorded over 400 yards on the Plantation Course at Kapalua for the first time in the ShotLink Era. In fact, only 1 drive was recorded on TOUR in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season over 400+ yards (Bubba Watson, Firestone CC (South) - 424 yards). Last season, this event recorded 10 of the 17 drives 400+ for the season.

Although the Plantation Course can yield some of the longest drives on TOUR, the wind can play a huge factor in dictating the driving distance.

On 2 measured drives per round for each player conducted on holes #3 and #15 at the Plantation Course the longest average drives was in 2002 where players averaged nearly 285 yards off the tee.

However, 2013 the field average in driving distance was the lowest since 2002 with a distance of 254.16 yards.

In 2015, the 2 measured driving distance holes (#3 and #15) averaged 272.2 yards. The last 2 seasons marked the longest averaged measured drives since 2005 when the 2 holes averaged 276.42 yards.

Fowler closed out his final 4 holes in regulation making birdie, eagle, birdie, birdie on holes 15 thru 18 at TPC Sawgrass Stadium course. Fowler played his final 4 holes a total of 11 strokes marking the fewest number of strokes needed on holes 15 through 18 at TPC Sawgrass.

Deutsche Bank Championship

Rickie Fowler led the field in Scrambling successfully salvaging par on 15 of 19 (78.95%) attempts from around the greens at TPC Boston. Fowler became only the 5th winner of a FedExCup Playoff event to lead the field in Scrambling and go onto victory (2007 Deutsche Bank, Mickelson; 2009 BMW, Woods; 2010 TOUR Champ., Furyk; 2013 BMW Z. Johnson). This marks Fowler's fourth event where he has led the field in Scrambling and the first where he has lead the field and went onto victory.

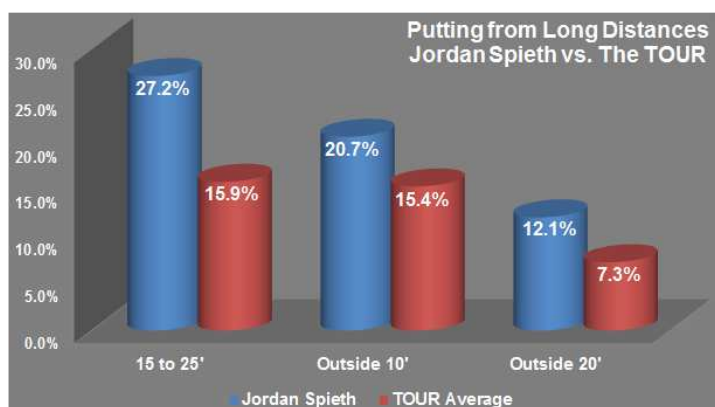

At the Travelers Championship the field average distance remaining from the hole after a tee shot on a par 4 or par 5 was 154.8 yards. Bubba Watson was the only player in the field who averaged less than 130 yards from the tee on all tee shots. His 127.4 yard average was 27.4 yards better than the field average and 13.3 yards better than the next best player (Rodgers: 140.7yards).

New ShotLink Record: Watson's 127.4 yard average after his tee shots at the 2015 Travelers Championship is a new PGA TOUR record by a winner in the ShotLink era (since 2003).
