ShotLink Keys to Victory for Nick Taylor

PGA TOUR Rookie in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season, Nick Taylor picked up his 1st career victory on TOUR in his 13th career start.

Final Round Putting: Nick Taylor made 7 putts from over 10 feet and 3 putts over 20 feet in the final round outperforming the field by +4.59 strokes with his putter in strokes gained: putting.

Nick Taylor made 178 feet of putts in the final round, making 7 putts from over 10 feet and 3 putts over 20 feet. Taylor's 178 feet of putts made in the final round was nearly 100 feet more putts made than the field average of 80' 1".

Taylor's 178 feet of putts made in the final round was the most feet of putts made in a 4th round by a winner of a PGA TOUR event since 2003.

Nick Taylor outperformed the field in the final round by +4.59 strokes in strokes gained: putting.

Taylor was 50.00% (7 of 14) from putting outside 10 feet in the final round.

For the week, Taylor ranked 2nd in total putts made outside 10 feet with 14. His 14 made putts from over 10 feet was 9 more than the field average of 5.

Last season, all 7 winners of the first 7 events of the season qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs. 4 of the 7 winners of the season qualified for the TOUR Championship.

2013-14 Wrap-Around: 186 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Of those 186 players, 115 made the 2014 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 63 made it to the BMW Championship and 26 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

2014-15 Wrap-Around: 206 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Of those 206 players, 118 made the 2015 FedExCup Playoffs, 94 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 64 made it to the BMW Championship and 25 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

At age 22, Justin Thomas became the **49**th of **95** (52%) winners on TOUR in there 20's since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. He also becomes the 7th consecutive winner on TOUR in his 20's. This ties the most consecutive events won by players in their 20's on TOUR since 1970.

Course & Hole Statistics CC of Jackson

Last season, the CC of Jackson played over a half of a stroke under par averaging 71.467 (-0.533) ranking as the 26^{th} easiest course on TOUR. The par 5, 3^{rd} hole played as the easiest hole on the course playing over a quarter of a stroke under par. The par 4, 6^{th} hole played as the toughest playing +0.17 strokes over par.

The back 9 at the CC of Jackson yielded nearly a hundred more birdies than the front 9 with 774. The back 9 also played over a guarter of a stroke (-0.301) easier than the front 9.

Smylie Kaufman

Smylie is off to a hot start in his Rookie campaign finishing T-10th at the Frys.com Open and winning in his 5th TOUR start (2nd of the 2015-16PGA TOUR season) at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Kaufman is 1 of only 5 players with 2 or more 10 10's through the first 3 events on TOUR this season. Kaufman currently ranks 3rd in the FedExCup standings. At age 23, Kaufman became the **48**th of 94 (51%) winners on TOUR in there 20's since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.

Final Round 61: Kaufman came from 7 shots back firing a final round 61 to capture the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. This was the largest come from behind victory since Tommy Gainey came from 7 shots back to win the 2012 McGladrey Classic (Kaufman entered the final round T-28th).

Smylie Kaufman climbed up the leaderboard in the final round outperforming the field by +8.282 in Strokes Gained: Total. His final round Strokes Gained: Total of +8.282 was the best final round SG: Total since Jason Day outperformed the field by +8.472 at the 2015 The Barclays.

In the final round, Smylie was +5.329 in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green, hitting 16 of 18 greens in regulation and averaged 27 feet on approach shots. On the greens: Smylie needed only 26 putts making 135' 6" of putts made, 4 putts over 10' and outperformed the field by +2.953 in Strokes Gained: Putting.

In the final round Smylie outperformed himself by 4 strokes Tee-to-Green, averaged 13 feet closer on approach shots and made birdie 50% of the time compared to his first 3 rounds of the week combined.

Smylie Kaufman averaged 327.6 yards off the tee in Driving Distance, **Driving**

measuring over 20 yards longer than the field average of 305.4 yards.

His average of 327.6 yards ranks 19th amongst longest Driving Distance by a winner since 1983.

Defending Champion of the Sanderson Farms Championship, Nick Taylor is set to make his 41st career start on TOUR. In 10 rounds played this season, Taylor has played 7 of the 10 under par.

Nick Taylor is showing early improvements in his putting from last season ranking 19th (+1.002) in Strokes Gained: Putting outperforming the field by over 1 stroke per round. Last season, Nick's longest putt made on TOUR was 56' 7" this season his longest putt made is already 57' 5".

Seung-Yul Noh

Seung-Yul Noh made big improved in several areas from the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season and last season. Noh's biggest improvement came in his going for green birdie or better percentage. In 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Noh had 139 attempts when going for the green and converted 79 of those for 56.83%. However last season, Noh improved 67 positions ranking 14th in going for green birdie or better percentage making birdie or better 65 of 102 attempts (63.73%).

Scott Stallings

2012 Sanderson Farms Champion Scott Stallings is seeking his 4th career win this week. Scott Stallings picked up his 2nd career PGA TOUR victory at the 2012 Sanderson Farms Championship. Stallings converted 4 total eagles en route to his victory in 2012. Since 1983, he is just the 8th PGA TOUR winner to make 4 eagles and the first since Rocco Mediate at the 2010 Frys.com Open.

Scott Stallings finished T-16th in his last start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Stallings had his 4th best performance in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green in an event on TOUR.

Officially Tim Clark has ranked inside the top 5 in 8 of 13 seasons on TOUR where ShotLink lasers have been used.
