

## 2016 Sony Open in Hawaii Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jimmy Walker

**9 Shot Victory:** Walker won by 9 strokes en route to victory at the Sony Open in Hawaii, marking the largest margin of victory in the 50 year history of the Sony Open (7 shots was the largest by Paul Azinger in 2000 & John Huston in 1998).

**Career most birdies in an event on TOUR:** Walker made 29 birdies at the Sony Open in Hawaii marking his career most birdies in an event.

**11 Straight One-Putts in Round 3:** Jimmy Walker was the first player at the Sony Open in Hawaii to have one-putts on holes 8 thru 18 in the same round since 1992 when we began tracking this data.

Walker recorded his 2nd best Strokes Gained: Putting performance of his career (+2.569 per round), 2nd behind his winning performance at the 2014 Frys.com Open (+3.074 per round).

Jimmy Walker ranked 2nd in putting from 20-25 feet making 3 of 6 attempts from this distance.

He also made a total of 418' 6" of putts made. Walker's average of 104' 8" of putts made per round was over 30 feet more than the field average of 69' 9".

Since 2012, Waialae CC has been the toughest driving course on TOUR. Only 49% of all drives at the Sony Open have found the fairways (12,034 of 24,514).

#### Jimmy Walker

Jimmy Walker seeks to become the first player since Steve Stricker (2009-11 John Deere Classic) to win the same event three consecutive years. Walker is set to make his 10<sup>th</sup> start at the Sony Open in Hawaii playing his last 12 consecutive rounds and 17 of his last 18 rounds under par at Waialae CC.

In Jimmy Walker's last 4 starts in Hawaii he has been nothing short of spectacular, posting 4 top 10's including 2 victories and one 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish. In his last 16 rounds he has a **66.75** scoring average and is a combined **76** under par.

Jimmy Walker is coming off a T-10<sup>th</sup> place finish at the Hyundai Tournament of Champions. His wedge game was solid for the week leading the field in proximity to the hole from 50-125 yards (9' 8").

### Zach Johnson

2009 Sony Open in Hawaii Champion, Zach Johnson is set to make his 11<sup>th</sup> start at this event. Zach is coming off a T-21<sup>st</sup> place finish at the Hyundai Tournament of Champions where he played his final 3 rounds at 13 under par.

Zach ranked first in Proximity to the Hole at the Hyundai TOC averaging 29' 5" to the flagstick on approach shots. On the greens, Zach was dialed in from 15-25 feet making 25.00% of his attempts from this distance ranking 4<sup>th</sup> last week.

Zach Johnson is known not necessarily for his distance off the tee however, he has been one of the most accurate players in driving accuracy in the last 12 seasons. Zach has ranked inside the top 30 in driving accuracy in 11 of the last 12 PGA TOUR seasons and has ranked inside the top 10 in 8 of the 12 seasons. The only year he was ranked outside of the top 30 was his 2nd year on TOUR in 2005 ranking 47th.

### K.J. Choi

2008 Sony Open in Hawaii champion, K.J. Choi is set to make his 15<sup>th</sup> appearance recording 1 win, 3 top 10's and 6 top 25 finishes.

K.J. Choi has made solid improvements with his putting since the 2012 PGA TOUR season. K.J. went from 172nd in strokes gained: putting losing **-.383** strokes per round to 18<sup>th</sup> last season gaining **+.411** strokes per round. Since 2012, K.J. has improved nearly a stroke per round on the greens.

### Kevin Kisner

Current FedExCup leader Kevin Kisner is coming off his 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive top 10 finish on TOUR finishing 9<sup>th</sup> at last week's Hyundai Tournament of Champions. Kisner has been one of the hottest players on TOUR finishing inside the top five 7 times since the start of last season. Since the start of last season only three players have more top 5 finishes than Kevin Kisner.

### Davis Love III

Davis Love III currently ranks 75<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings and is set to make his 722<sup>nd</sup> PGA TOUR start. Davis is set to make his 16<sup>th</sup> start at the Sony Open and seeks to make the cut for the first time in his last three starts at this event. Davis has **6 top 10 finishes** at the Sony Open in Hawaii, ranking as the T-2<sup>nd</sup> most top 10's he has on TOUR in an event without a victory.

### **Brandt Snedeker**

Brandt Snedeker is coming off a solid performance at the Hyundai Tournament of Champions finishing T-3<sup>rd</sup>. Snedeker had all facets of his game working last week ranking 9<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green & 2<sup>nd</sup> in Strokes Gained: Putting.

Brandt Snedeker ranked T-1<sup>st</sup> in the field in Greens in Regulation last week hitting his mark 88.89% (64 of 72) of the time. **This marked only the 2<sup>nd</sup> time where Brandt has led an event for GIR's. This was also the most GIR's he has ever hit in an event on TOUR.**

Brandt Snedeker is known for being one of the best putters on the PGA TOUR. Since his Rookie season in 2007, he has ranked inside the top 20 in Strokes Gained: Putting in 7 of his 9 years on TOUR. Snedeker is 1 of just 3 players to have ranked inside the top 20 in this category in 7 or more seasons.

In his career on TOUR he is an outstanding **+341.16** strokes better than the PGA TOUR on the greens.

### **Adam Scott**

Adam Scott is set to make his 7<sup>th</sup> appearance at the Sony Open. Scott's best finish at this event came in 2009, T-2<sup>nd</sup> with David Toms and 2 shots back of winner Zach Johnson. In his last appearance in 2014, Scott finished T-8<sup>th</sup> falling 7 shots short of winner Jimmy Walker.

This Season, Scott shot his 10<sup>th</sup> career 63 or better on TOUR in the final round of the CIMB Classic finishing solo 2<sup>nd</sup>. Scott currently ranks 14<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings. Adam finished 106<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings last season marking his lowest rank in the standings since the 2009 PGA TOUR season where he finished 110<sup>th</sup>.

Year in and year out, Adam Scott is one of the TOURs best ball strikers ranking outside of the top 25 in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green only twice in his last 8 PGA TOUR seasons. However, on the greens he has struggled only ranking inside the top 100 in Strokes Gained: Putting in one season of his last 8 on TOUR.

### Matt Kuchar

Matt Kuchar is set to make his 13<sup>th</sup> start at the Sony Open in Hawaii and has finished inside the top 10 in his last 4 starts (2011-T5, 2013-T5, 2014 -T8 & 2015 – T3).

Graeme McDowell currently ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 win and 2 top 10 finishes.

McDowell is seeking to earn his first trip into the top 30 by year end at the TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola. 4 of the first 7 winners last season finished inside the top 30 of the FedExCup standings.

In three events played of the 2015/16 PGA TOUR season, Graeme McDowell has made 60 birdies, 108 pars, 12 bogeys and 5 double bogeys playing his first 216 holes of the TOUR season at 37 under par. Graeme's average of 5.00 birdies per round ranks T-17<sup>th</sup> on TOUR this season. McDowell currently ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in Driving Accuracy hitting 75.74% of his fairways.

### Justin Thomas

Justin Thomas is set to make his 2<sup>nd</sup> start at the Sony Open in Hawaii. Thomas finished T-6<sup>th</sup> last year shooting his first of 2 career rounds of 61 (round 2 at 2015 Sony & round 2 at CIMB Classic) on TOUR. Justin currently ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the current FedExCup standings on the strength of 1 win (CIMB Classic), 2 top 10's & 3 top 25's this season.

Since the start of the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season no one has more rounds in the 60's and more birdies than Justin Thomas. In this timeframe Justin has 71 rounds in the 60's and has recorded 541 total birdies.

### Russell Knox

Russell Knox is coming off a 27<sup>th</sup> place finish at last week's Hyundai Tournament of Champions where he t-led the field in Greens in Regulation for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in his career on TOUR.
