ShotLink Keys to Victory for Robert Streb

Robert Streb picked up his 1st career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 49th career start.

Final Round Strokes Gained: Putting: Robert Streb outperformed the field by over 3 strokes (+3.22) with his putter in the final round making 5 putts from 10 feet and over including his 33' 3" birdie on the par 3, 17th hole.

In the first 3 rounds, Robert Streb outperformed the field by a combined +1.96 in strokes gained: tee-to-green. However, in the final round he outperformed the field by +2.58 strokes tee-to-green over a half a stroke better than his first 3 rounds.

Streb made a total of 6 putts from 10 feet and over in the first 3 rounds compared to 5 in the final round alone.

For the week, Streb outperformed the field by a total of +6.77 strokes on the greens at RSM Classic.

Last season, all 7 winners of the first 7 events of the season qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs. 4 of the 7 winners of the season qualified for the TOUR Championship.

2013-14 Wrap-Around: 186 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Of those 186 players, 115 made the 2014 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 63 made it to the BMW Championship and 26 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

2014-15 Wrap-Around: 206 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Of those 206 players, 118 made the 2015 FedExCup Playoffs, 94 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 64 made it to the BMW Championship and 25 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

2015-16 Sanderson Farms Championship *(featured groups)*

Davis Love III

Davis Love III became the 3rd oldest winner in PGA TOUR history (51 years, 4 months, and 10 days) when he won the 2015 Wyndham Championship. Love posted rounds of 64-66-69-64 marking just the 2nd time in his career where he's had 2 rounds of 64 in the same week (2008 Children's Miracle Network). With his victory, Davis made the FEC Playoffs for the first time since the 2012 PGA TOUR season.

Davis moved from 186th to 76th in the FedExCup standings with his 21st victory on TOUR marking the biggest move in the FedExCup in tournament history.

PGA TOUR victories spanning 4 Decades

Davis Love III won the 2015 Wyndham Championship for his 21st career victory on the PGA TOUR. Love also became just the 3rd player on record with PGA TOUR victories spanning 4 decades. He joined Raymond Floyd (60s', 70's, 80's 90's) & Sam Snead (30's, 40's, 50's 60's) as the only 3 players to accomplish this feat.

2 Eagles in Final Round: Davis Love III made eagles on both par 5's in the final round marking the 13th time in his PGA TOUR career where he's had 2 or more eagles in the same round and the first time since the 3rd round of the 2008 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open.

The RSM Classic host is set to make his 6th start at the RSM Classic. Love III best finish at the RSM Classic was a T-4th in 2012.

Justin Thomas led the field en route to his CIMB victory averaging 7.50 birdies per round totaling 30 birdies for the week. His 30 birdies for the week was the T-9th most birdies made in a 4 round event on TOUR since 1983 and was 12 more than the field average of 18.

Bill Haas

Bill Haas is making his first appearance since his singles victory over Sangmoon Bae at the Presidents Cup. Haas is set to make his 3rd start at the RSM Classic and first of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season. Haas has 8 consecutive rounds in the 60's at this event finishing T-22nd last season & 2nd in 2010.

Smylie Kaufman

Smylie is off to a hot start in his Rookie campaign making all 4 cuts in his 4 events played including finishing T-10th at the Frys.com Open and winning in his 5th TOUR start (2nd of the 2015-16PGA TOUR season) at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Kaufman is 1 of only 14 players with 2 or more top 10's through the first 6 events on TOUR this season. Kaufman currently ranks 4th in the FedExCup standings.

Final Round 61: Kaufman came from 7 shots back firing a final round 61 to capture the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. This was the largest come from behind victory since Tommy Gainey came from 7 shots back to win the 2012 RSM Classic (Kaufman entered the final round T-28th).

Smylie Kaufman climbed up the leaderboard in the final round outperforming the field by +8.282 in Strokes Gained: Total. His final round Strokes Gained: Total of +8.282 was the best final round SG: Total since Jason Day outperformed the field by +8.472 at the 2015 The Barclays.

In the final round, Smylie was +5.329 in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green, hitting 16 of 18 greens in regulation and averaged 27 feet on approach shots. On the greens: Smylie needed only 26 putts making 135' 6" of putts made, 4 putts over 10' and outperformed the field by +2.953 in Strokes Gained: Putting.

In the final round Smylie outperformed himself by 4 strokes Tee-to-Green, averaged 13 feet closer on approach shots and made birdie 50% of the time compared to his first 3 rounds of the week combined.

Smylie Kaufman averaged 327.6 yards off the tee in Driving Distance, measuring over 20 yards longer than the field average of 305.4 yards.

His average of 327.6 yards ranks 19th amongst longest Driving Distance by a winner since 1983.

Graeme McDowell

Fresh of his 3rd PGA TOUR win at the OHL Classic at Mayakoba, Graeme McDowell currently ranks 7th in the FedExCup standings. McDowell is seeking his 1st trip to the TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola (4 of the first 7 winners from last season made it to the TOUR Championship) and hopes his early victory will help his chances in making the top 30 by seasons end.

Graeme McDowell one-putted over half of his holes played (38 of 72 holes) at the OHL Classic at Mayakoba. McDowell made nearly 3 birdies more than any other player per round and 15 more birdies than the field average of 12 for the event. Graeme's 27 total birdies for the week tied his most birdies in an event in his career on TOUR (27 at 2011 Hyundai TOC).

Graeme McDowell struggled in a number of different categories last season including his play from on the greens. McDowell went from ranking 1st in Strokes Gained: Putting in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season to T-96th last season.

Most Improved on TOUR: Snedeker was the most improved player on the PGA TOUR when putting from 5 to 10 feet. In 2013-14 he ranked 154th on TOUR from this distance converting 52.3% of his efforts. Last season he jumped up to 5th on TOUR converting a career best 64.2% of his efforts from this distance.

Sea Island resident Matt Kuchar is set to make his 5th appearance at the RSM Classic. In his first 4 starts he is yet to finish outside of the top 25 and is yet to shoot a round over par (16 of 16). Of his 16 rounds at the RSM Classic 13 of them have been 68 or better, marking the most rounds of 68 or better at Sea Island.

Peter Malnati

Peter Malnati picked up his 1st career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 22nd career start. At age 28, Malnati was the 5th first timer to win in 5 PGA TOUR events this season. Malnati also became the 50th of 97 (52%) winners on TOUR in there 20's since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.
