## ShotLink Keys to Victory for Bubba Watson

### 13.3 Yards Shorter Approach Shot Remaining than Everyone

At the 2015 Travelers Championship the field average distance remaining from the hole after a tee shot on a par 4 or par 5 was 154.8 yards. Bubba Watson was the only player in the field who averaged less than 130 yards from the tee on all tee shots. His 127.4 yard average was 27.4 yards better than the field average and 13.3 yards better than the next best player (Rodgers: 140.7 yards).

New ShotLink Record: Watson's 127.4 yard average after his tee shots at the 2015 Travelers Championship was a new PGA TOUR record by a winner in the ShotLink era (since 2003). Watson is the only PGA TOUR winner to average less than 130 yards remaining after a tee shot in more than 1 victory in the ShotLink era.

## Bubba Watson

Bubba Watson is scheduled to make his $10^{\text {th }}$ career start at the Travelers Championship this week. This event serves as home to his first (2010) \& $8^{\text {th }}$ victories on the PGA TOUR. He's accumulated 5 top-ten finishes in his previous 9 starts here. Since missing the cut in 2006, Watson has not opened with a round higher than 67 at TPC River Highlands. In fact, he's been inside the top 5 of the leader board after 18 holes in 4 of his 9 career starts here marking his most times inside the top 5 after 18 holes of any event he's played on TOUR.

Watson has accumulated 154 total birdies at the Travelers Championship over the course of his 9 career starts.

Entering this week, he's just 18 birdies shy of tying his own record for events with the most birdies. This should be no problem for Bubba considering he's had more than 18 birdies in 6 of 9 starts at the Travelers.

Par 5 Birdie or Better Percentage: Bubba Watson has led an event 17 times over the course of his career for par 5 birdie or better percentage (including in 3 of his 9 PGA TOUR victories). However, he's only accomplished this feat multiple times at the same event three times (3 times at Travelers and 2 times at the Farmers Insurance Open \& WGC-Bridgestone Invitational).

311 Yard Average off the Tee on 68 Par 5's: In his career at TPC River Highlands, Watson has managed to hit 53 of 68 drives ( $78 \%$ ) over 300 yards on the par 5 's with an average drive of 311 yards. His average $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot remaining on the par 5's at the Travelers Championship is 243 yards.

Keegan gets off to a great start in the first 2 rounds at the Travelers Championship hitting 76\% of his GIR's and is a combined 26 under par. However, his final 2 rounds are a different story averaging $60 \%$ GIR's and is a combined 1 under par.

Keegan Bradley combines Driving Distance and Driving Accuracy better than anyone the last 6 seasons on TOUR. Since 2011, Keegan Bradley is the only player on TOUR who has ranked inside the top 15 in Total Driving.

## Kevin Streelman

2014 Travelers Champion, Kevin Streelman is set to make his $9^{\text {th }}$ appearance at this event and $23^{\text {rd }}$ of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season. Streelman currently ranks $62^{\text {nd }}$ in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 2 top 10's and 7 top 25 finishes this season.

Streelman was over 4 strokes better on the back 9 than the front 9 in Strokes Gained: Putting. He needed 6 fewer putts on the back 9 and made 5 more putts over 5 feet than the front 9 including a $20^{\prime \prime} 8$ " putt on hole 14 and a $377^{\prime \prime}$ " putt on the 16th hole.

Streelman's Back 9 score of 28 tied the lowest back 9 score by a winner since David Duval's back 9 score of 28 and final round 59 at the 1999 Humana Challenge.
