Tyler Duncan and Conrad Shindler tied at Price Cutter Charity Championship

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Another wet day in Springfield led to a delay to the resumption of the first round. Once play began, Tyler Duncan made a move up the leaderboard and is currently tied with overnight leader Conrad Shindler, at 9-under-par, as second-round play was halted at the Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Dr Pepper due to darkness.

Duncan and Shindler are one in front of Chris Naegel, K.H. Lee, Talor Gooch, Scott Harrington, Martin Piller and Austin Cook. The second round will resume on Saturday at 7:20 a.m. local time.

After opening with a 5-under 67, the 28-year-old from Columbus, Ind. recorded five birdies and one bogey through 11 holes. At No. 33 on the Web.com Tour money list, Duncan is on a mission to join fellow Purdue Boilermaker Adam Schenk on the PGA TOUR next year.

Duncan will resume his second round on the par-4 12th Saturday morning.

Shindler, like half of the field, will not start his second round until Saturday afternoon. He has a chance this weekend to make it back-to-back Tour wins for the Texas A&M Aggies. Martin Piller won last week's Ellie Mae Classic at TPC Stonebrae in thrilling fashion.

"That'd be a lot of fun," said Shindler. "I was really happy for Martin. I was glad I was there to watch him win and see the trophy presentation."
