ShotLink Keys to Victory for Danny Lee (2015 Champion)

Danny Lee was the last man standing after a four-way playoff at the 2015 The Greenbrier Classic. With his victory, Danny Lee moved from 57th to 15th in the FedExCup standings.

Strokes Gained: Putting: Danny Lee ranked 7th in Strokes Gained: Putting marking the 13th winner (2014-15) to rank inside the top 10 in this category and go onto victory.

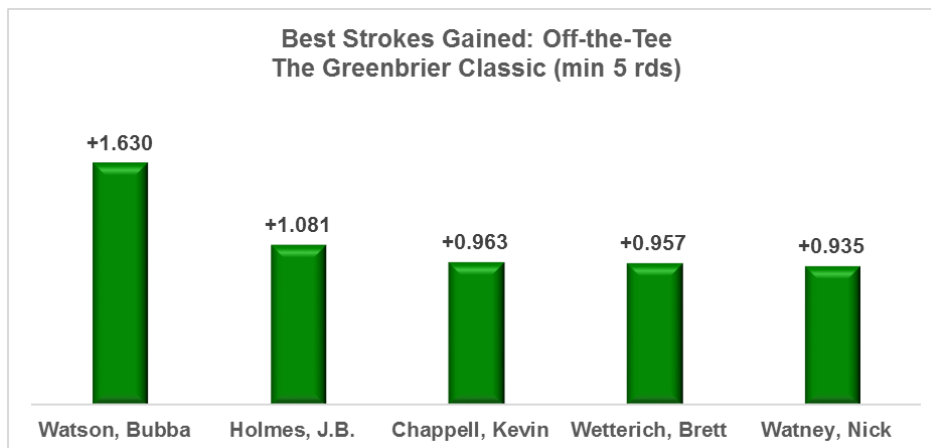

Last week at the Quicken Loans National, Charles Howell III ranked 12th or better in several key categories, ranking 3rd in Proximity to the Hole averaging 6' 4" closer in proximity to the hole than the field.
