ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jason Day

Most Aggressive Player: Jason Day was the most aggressive player on the par 5's during the 2016 Arnold Palmer Invitational. He went for the green on 15 of the 16 going for it holes (93.8%) leading the field in this category. By comparison, the field average for going for the green was 57.3%.

Day went onto convert birdie or better on 75% of his going for it attempts. For the week, he played the par 5's at 10-under ranking T-5th in the field.

Birdie on 71st hole: Jason Day made a critical birdie on the par 3 – 17th hole enroute to victory at the 2016 Arnold Palmer Invitational.

For the week, there were 112 par 3 birdies on the course out of 1,568 attempts. This works out to a birdie conversion of 7.14%. Standing on the 71st tee, Day had made just 2 birdies on the first 15 par 3's of the week (13%). In the final round Day made birdie on a hole where just 8 of 76 players were able to convert birdie for the day (10.5%).

Bay Hill had the longest proximity to hole from the rough last year on TOUR (51" 2" feet). Players averaged over 50 feet on approach shots from the rough on 4 of the 10 par 4's last year (18th hole the toughest at 57' 2".

The field was a combined +206 over par on all par 4 approach shots from the rough last year.

Champions on the 18th hole in the final round: Since 1983 (last 34 years). The 72nd hole at API has yielded anything from hole out eagles to double bogeys. Last year, Jason Day got up and down from 31 yards out of the left greenside bunker. Day converted the 4 ft. par putt for the win.

Jason Day led the 2015-16 PGA TOUR for Strokes Gained: Putting outperforming the TOUR by +1.130 strokes per round. Jason Day set the ShotLink record for best SG: Putting average in history. Since 2004, no other player was better than Jesper Parnevik in 2007 outperforming the TOUR by +0.979 strokes per round on the greens. This season, Day has gotten off to a mediocre start on the greens ranking **185**th **of 205** ranked players.

In his last 2 starts on TOUR, Martin Kaymer has finished inside of the top-25. Kaymer finished T-4th at the 2017 Honda Classic & T-23rd at the 2017 WGC-Mexico Championship. Henrik Stenson

2013 FedExCup Champion, Henrik Stenson is set to make his 9th appearance at the Arnold Palmer Invitational. Henrik has played his last 10 rounds under par at Bay Hill. In the last 4 Arnold Palmer Invitational, Henrik Stenson is yet to finish outside of the top 8. Since 2013, Stenson is the most accurate and has the lowest scoring average among any player with 9 or more rounds at this event.

With 3 top-10 finishes in his last 5 starts at the Arnold Palmer Invitational, Justin Rose is set to make his 12th start at this event. His best finish at this event came in 2013 where he finished solo 2nd.

This season, Justin Rose currently ranks 15th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of 3 top-5 finishes. Rose made the TOUR Championship for 6 consecutive seasons until his 51st finish in the FEC standings last season.

Rory McIlroy

2016 FedExCup Champion Rory McIlroy, is coming off a T-7th place finish in his last event the WGC-Mexico Championship. McIlroy is set to make his 3rd start at the Arnold Palmer Invitational. Last season, he shot a final round 65 vaulting him from T-64th to T-27th.

At last year's Arnold Palmer Invitational, Rory McIlroy ranked 15th in Strokes Gained: Putting outperforming the field by +0.972 strokes per round. Rory was 5 of 15 (33.3%) from beyond 25 feet leading the field in percentage of putts made from over 25 feet.

Rickie Fowler

Rickie Fowler picked up his 4th career PGA TOUR victory moving from 58th to 10th in the FedExCup standings. Fowler's +1.848 Strokes Gained: Putting was the 2nd best performance of the week and the 4th best of his career in a 4-round event on the PGA TOUR.

Perfect Putting Inside 7 Feet: Rickie Fowler was 1 of just 3 players (Chad Collins and Zach Johnson) who were perfect when putting inside 7 feet at PGA National (Champion). For the week, Fowler was a perfect 57 for 57 (100%) from this range.

No 3-Putts: Rickie Fowler was 1 of 14 players who went the entire week without recording a 3-putt on PGA National (Champion). This marks 19th career event where Fowler has gone all 4 rounds without recording a 3-putt on the PGA TOUR and first time since the 2015-16 Northern Trust. Fowler's current streak without a 3-putt extends 130 holes on the PGA TOUR (T-6 best active streak on TOUR).

Fowler went an impressive 5 for 7 (71.4%) when putting from 10 to 15 feet ranking T-1 from this range for the week. His 71% conversion rate from this range was 38% better than the field average of 33%.

Putting Outside 20: Fowler also tied his career best performance on the PGA TOUR by converting 5 putts from beyond 20 feet at PGA National (Champion) tying Louis Oosthuizen for the 2nd best performance from this range for the week (O'Hair made 7 – most). This marks the 6th time where Fowler's converted 5 putts beyond 20 feet in an event the PGA TOUR.

Scoring Average Leader This Season: Rickie Fowler currently leads the TOUR in scoring average. Rickie's 68.70 scoring average is over 2 strokes lower than the TOUR average of 71.30.

Adam Hadwin

Adam Hadwin picked up his first victory in his 78th career start on the PGA TOUR moving from 15th to 4th in the FedExCup standings marking the first time he's cracked the top 5 in his FedExCup career.

2nd **Best Approach-the-Green Performance of Career:** Adam Hadwin outperformed the Valspar Championship field by over 2 strokes per round with his approach game ranking 2nd in the field. This marks his 2nd best week on the PGA TOUR with his irons (2011 RBC Canadian Open ranked 1st for SG: Approach outperforming field by +2.095).

Hadwin was dialed-in with the irons ranking inside the top 10 in several approach shot categories for the week.

Over 400 Feet of Putts: Hadwin converted a field leading 422' 11" of putts for the week including two bombs from outside of 50 feet on the weekend. He's the first winner to convert over 400 feet of putts in a 4-round event since Jordan Spieth won the 2015-16 DEAN & DELUCA converting 431 feet of putts.
