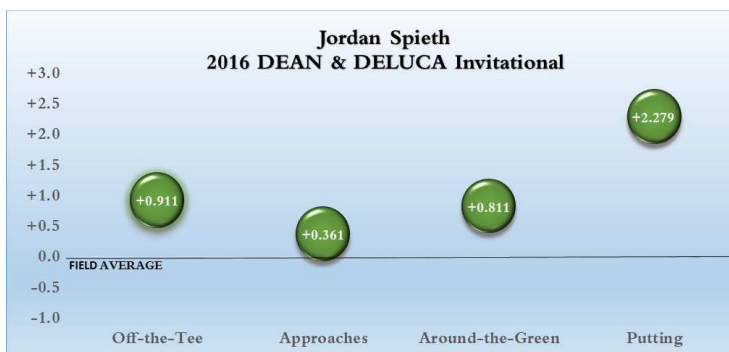


## 2017 DEAN & DELUCA Invitational Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jordan Spieth

Jordan Spieth picked up his 2<sup>nd</sup> win of last season and 8<sup>th</sup> of his career when he won the 2016 DEAN & DELUCA Invitational.



52% of Jordan's total gains at Colonial CC came from his performance on the greens.

Last season, Colonial CC ranked as the 7<sup>th</sup> easiest course to putt on from 10-15 feet (31.4%). Defending champion, Jordan Spieth made 50% of his efforts from this distance going 4 of 8 last season.

### 2017 DEAN & DELUCA Invitational *(featured groups)*

#### Jordan Spieth

#7 in the FedExCup standings, Jordan Spieth is set to make his 5<sup>th</sup> start at the DEAN & DELUCA Invitational. Defending champion, Jordan Spieth has yet to finish outside the top 15 (2016: Won, 2015: T2, 2014: T-14th & 2013: T-7<sup>th</sup>). Jordan is coming off his 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive missed cut at THE PLAYERS & AT&T Byron Nelson.

Since 2013, no other player has a better make percentage from outside of 20 feet at Colonial CC than Jordan Spieth. Jordan has gone 20 of 85 from outside 20 feet making nearly 1 of every 4 putts from over this distance.

In 108 starts as a professional Jordan has finished inside the top 5, 27.8% of the time.

### Zach Johnson

Two-time champion of the DEAN & DELUCA Invitational (2012 & 2010) Zach Johnson is set to make his 12<sup>th</sup> appearance at this event and 13<sup>th</sup> start of 2016-17 PGA TOUR Season. Zach currently ranks 95<sup>th</sup> in the race for the FedExCup on the strength of 2 top-10's and 4 top-25 finishes this season.

Colonial CC has been Zach Johnson's comfort zone, playing 26 of his last 32 rounds in the 60's and 37 of his 44 career rounds at par or better at this event.

### Billy Horschel

Coming off his 4<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR win at the 2017 AT&T Byron Nelson, Billy Horschel is set to make his 17<sup>th</sup> start this season. Billy Horschel moved from 71<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings ranking inside of the top-30 in the FEC standings for the 1<sup>st</sup> time since week #7 this season.

Horschel became the 7<sup>th</sup> player this season to rank inside of the top-5 in Greens in Regulation & SG: Putting en route to victory. Horschel was also the first player since Russell Henley (2017 Shell Houston Open) to rank first in SG: Putting and go onto win.

Billy Horschel got it done on and around the greens ranking 9<sup>th</sup> in SG: Around-the-Green and 1<sup>st</sup> in SG: Putting. Horschel made his career 2<sup>nd</sup> most feet of putts made for the week at 453' 9" of total putts. His 453' 9" of total putts made included his longest putt made of his career in the final round on the 14<sup>th</sup> hole measuring 59' 3".

The 2017 THE PLAYERS champion is making his first start since his 2<sup>nd</sup> PGA TOUR victory a couple weeks ago. Currently 22<sup>nd</sup> in the FedExCup standings, Si Woo Kim is seeking to make it to the TOUR Championship for his 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive season on TOUR.

### Sergio Garcia

Since the start of last season, Sergio Garcia has 2 wins & 6 top-10's in 24 starts. During this stretch, Sergio has only missed 2 cuts and is a cumulative 93-under par. Sergio currently ranks 13<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings and is seeking to get back to the TOUR Championship for the first time since the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.
