Jason Day became the first player in major championship history to finish the week at 20-under par. Since Jason Day's victory at the 2015 PGA Championship, Henrik Stenson was the $2^{\text {nd }}$ player to accomplish this feat at 2016 The OPEN. Day was also the $5^{\text {th }}$ Australian born player to win the PGA Championship and first to win a major since Adam Scott won the 2013 Masters.
