

Defending Champion: Jimmy Walker

Jimmy Walker picked up his 6th career PGA TOUR victory and 1st major championship at the 2016 PGA Championship.

Jimmy Walker outperformed the field by +2.52 strokes from on and around the greens ranking 2nd in SG: Around-the-Green & 10th in SG: Putting.

Jimmy Walker's 32.7 scoring average on the back 9 was 3 strokes better than the field average of 35.7. His 13-under par on the back 9 was two strokes better than the next best player Daniel Summerhayes who was 11-under on the inward 9 holes.

Jimmy Walker averaged a stroke better per round on the back 9 than his front 9 at the 2016 PGA Championship. Walker was 6 strokes better on the back 9 greens then the front 9 in SG: Putting (+5.84 on the back 9).

The final 3 holes "The Green Mile" at Quail Hollow Club have been the toughest 3 finishing holes on the PGA TOUR since 2003 with an average of +0.916 over par.

The Green Mile accounts for 25% of all bogeys, 38% of all doubles, and 51% of all triples or worse at Quail Hollow Club.

The field is a combined +5,899 over par on holes 16 thru 18 since 2003 (-1,270 on all other holes).

Rory McIloy / Jon Rahm / Rickie Fowler:

Rory McIlroy, Jon Rahm & Rickie Fowler have accounted for 2 wins, 16 top-5's, 21 top-10's and 29 top-25 finishes in 44 combined PGA TOUR starts this season. Despite Rory being the only player of the 3 without a win this season, he is the only player with a major championship (4 majors: 2 PGA's 1 Open & 1 U.S. Open).

In Major Championships, no one has accumulated more birdies than Phil Mickelson. Since 1995, Phil has totaled1,107 birdies in majors marking the most of any player.

Sergio Garcia / Brooks Koepka / Jordan Spieth:

The 3 Major champions this season have a combined average age of 29 years old. Since 2010, the average age of a PGA Championship winners has been 28 years old. The youngest in this timeframe was Rory McIlroy who was 23 years 3 months old. Jordan Spieth is seeking to become the youngest player to win the career grand slam in history at age 24 years 0 months and 17 days (on Sunday).

Since 2013, Henrik Stenson has hit 71.2% of his greens in regulation, marking the best Greens in Regulation percentage of any player in Majors (min 22 rounds played).

Jason Day became the first player in major championship history to finish the week at 20-under par. Since Jason Day's victory at the 2015 PGA Championship, Henrik Stenson was the 2nd player to accomplish this feat at 2016 The OPEN. Day was also the 5th Australian born player to win the PGA Championship and first to win a major since Adam Scott won the 2013 Masters.
