Presidents Cup Notes

With the 19-11 win this week, the United States owns a 10-1-1 record in the 12 playings of the biennial event. The Presidents Cup returns to Royal Melbourne Golf Club in Australia in 2019, the site of the lone International Team victory in 1998. The largest overall margin of victory in Presidents Cup history after all sessions is 11 points, when the U.S. defeated the International team 21.5 to 10.5 in 2000.

Daniel Berger, needing one-half point to clinch the Presidents Cup for the U.S. Team, closed out Si Woo Kim 2 and 1 to become the first-ever Presidents Cup "rookie" to clinch the Cup. Berger, 24, is also the youngest player to clinch the Cup for either side.

Four players on the U.S. Team went undefeated this week:

Dustin Johnson 4-0-1 Rickie Fowler 3-0-1 Phil Mickelson 3-0-1 Kevin Kisner 2-0-2

Phil Mickelson, playing in his record 12th Singles match, defeated Adam Hadwin 2 and 1 and is now 4-5-3 in Presidents Cup Singles play. Playing as a Captain's Selection, Mickelson finished the week 3-0-1 and is 6-0-2 in the last two Presidents Cups, both as a Captain's Selection. His overall record at the Presidents Cup is 26-16-13.

In his last five Presidents Cup matches dating back to 2009, Phil Mickelson has posted a 15-3-4 record.

Led by Justin Thomas' 3-1-1 record, the six U.S. Presidents Cup "rookies" combined for a record of 11-7-4.

With Singles losses on Sunday, Matt Kuchar (0-4-0) and Jordan Spieth (0-3-0) are both winless in Singles play in their Presidents Cup careers.

Jordan Spieth and Patrick Reed became just the 11th duo to earn three or more points together on the week, posting a 3-0-1 record. Two pairings – Louis Oosthuizen/Branden Grace (2015) and Tiger Woods/Steve Stricker (2009)—have won four full points.
