# ShotLink Keys to Victory for Billy Hurley III

Entering the 2016 Quicken Loans National 198<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings, Billy Hurley III picked up his first PGA TOUR victory and moved up 128 positions to 70<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings. Hurley became the 14<sup>th</sup> first time winner of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season.

Billy's approaches were his key to victory, outperforming the field by +2.450 strokes per round in SG: Approach-the-Green. 80% of Billy's total strokes gained came from his Approach-the-Green and Around-the-Green performance at Congressional CC.

Billy Hurley was dialed in with his approach shots, leading the field in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green outperforming the field by +2.598 shots per round. Hurley III hit 49 of his 72 approach shots better than the field average for the week.

For the week, Billy Hurley III made a total of 22 birdies. His 22 total birdies were the most in his career in a 4-round event on TOUR and was the 2<sup>nd</sup> most in the field.

# **Justin Thomas**

Justin Thomas is set to make his 3<sup>rd</sup> start at the Quicken Loans National playing all 8 of his rounds at this event at par or better. Thomas comes into this event as the highest ranked player in the FedExCup standings (3<sup>rd</sup>). Justin Thomas can move to first in the FedExCup with a t-2 or better finish this week (210 points back).

Justin Thomas is a combined 103-under par, the most of any player on TOUR this season. Justin has 23 rounds under 70, including his 59 at the Sony Open in Hawaii.

Justin Thomas leads the TOUR in several scoring categories, including birdie average making nearly 5 birdies per round played. Justin makes birdie or better on over a quarter (27.1%) of the holes he plays on TOUR. Justin has made birdie or better on 249 of 918 holes played this season.

# **Patrick Reed**




