ShotLink Keys to Victory for Branden Grace

+9.207 Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green: Branden Grace ranked 2nd in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green marking the 5th straight champion of the RBC Heritage to rank inside the top 10 in this category. For the week, Grace outperformed the RBC Heritage field by a total of +9.207 in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green marking his career best performance tee-to-green on TOUR.

The last 8 RBC Heritage champions have averaged 24 missed greens in regulation at Harbour Town GL and have salvage par 80% of the time. Branden Grace won with the same type of formula ranking 3rd in scrambling salvaging par on 22 of 28 (78.57%) missed greens. The last 8 winners have averaged a rank of 8th in scrambling, Grace was the 3rd out of the last 4 champions at the RBC Heritage to rank inside the top 3 for Scrambling at this event.

Entering the RBC Heritage, Branden grace ranked outside the top 100 in several putting statistics including Strokes Gained: Putting giving up a quarter of a shot per round on the greens. However, at the RBC Heritage, Grace outperformed the field by +1.348 strokes per round and after hitting a green in regulation he converted 15 birdies or better ranking T-7th in the field.

2011 RBC Heritage Champion, Brandt Snedeker is set to make his 12th appearance at this event. The 2012 FedExCup Champion currently ranks 35th in the FEC standings this season. Snedeker is coming off a T-27th finish at the Masters Tournament.

Since the start of the 2011 PGA TOUR season no one has more rounds of 64 or better than Brandt Snedeker. His 22 rounds of 64 or better is 2 clear of the next best players Webb Simpson, Ryan Palmer & Jimmy Walker with 20.

In this timeframe, Brandt Snedeker has 2 rounds of 64 or better at the RBC Heritage 2011 final round (won) & 2015 round two (T26).

2013 Victory at RBC Heritage:

In the first 3 rounds, McDowell made a total of 9 putts over 6 feet and was **+2.326** in strokes gained-putting. However, in the final round McDowell made 6 putts over 6 feet including a 19'6" par putt on hole 13 and a 7'6" birdie putt on his 16th hole outperforming the field by **+3.541** strokes and 1 stroke better than his first 3 rounds combined with his putter.

Graeme McDowell (33, 2013 Champion) & Matt Kuchar (35, 2014 Champion) are 2 of 8 previous winners in their 30's to capture the RBC Heritage. 8 of the last 10 and 11 of the last 14 winners of the RBC Heritage have been in their 30's.

Matt Kuchar finished T-4th at last week's Masters Tournament moving up 28 spots in the FedExCup standings. Kuchar moved from 73rd to 45th with his T-4th place finish and was the 5th biggest mover from last week.
