ShotLink Keys to Victory for Peter Malnati

Peter Malnati picked up his 1st career victory on the PGA TOUR in his 22nd career start. At age 28, Malnati was the 5th first timer to win in 5 PGA TOUR events last season. At this event, Malnati became the **50th** of 97 (52%) winners on TOUR in there 20's since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.

Strokes Gained: Putting: Peter Malnati made a combined 495' 7" of putts made for the event outperforming the Sanderson Farms field by +11.85 (+2.963 per round) total strokes on the greens.

Peter Malnati got it done on the greens at the Sanderson Farms Championship outperforming the field by nearly 12 strokes. Malnati outperformed the Sanderson Farms field by +11.851 strokes marking the 7th best Strokes Gained: Putting total on TOUR since 2004 (inception of SG: Putting).

Peter Malnati made 16 putts over 10 feet marking the T-2nd most putts made over this distance by a winner on TOUR (since 2004). Malnati's 16 putts made over 10 feet were 5 more than the next best player in the field.

In the last 2 PGA TOUR Seasons, all 14 winners of the first 7 events of the season qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs. 8 of the 14 winners of the season qualified for the TOUR Championship (4 in each season).

2013-14 Wrap-Around: 186 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season. Of those 186 players, 115 made the 2014 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 63 made it to the BMW Championship and 26 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

2014-15 Wrap-Around: 206 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season. Of those 206 players, 118 made the 2015 FedExCup Playoffs, 94 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 64 made it to the BMW Championship and 25 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

2015-16 Wrap-Around: 209 players earned FedExCup points before the start of the new calendar year in the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season. Of those 209 players, 116 made the 2016 FedExCup Playoffs, 92 made it to the Deutsche Bank Championship, 65 made it to the BMW Championship and 27 made it to the TOUR Championship by Coca Cola.

Course & Hole Statistics CC of Jackson

Last season, the CC of Jackson played over a stroke under par averaging 70.47 (-1.53) ranking as the 5th easiest course on TOUR. The par 4, 15th hole played as the easiest hole on the course playing over a quarter of a stroke under par. The par 4, 16th hole played as the toughest playing +0.153 strokes over par.

The back 9 at the CC of Jackson yielded nearly a hundred more birdies or better than the front 9 with 785. The back 9 also played nearly a quarter of a stroke (-0.240) easier than the front 9.

Since 2009, David Toms has never ranked outside of the top 30 in driving accuracy. During this timeframe he has hit a total of **5,364 of 7,482** (71.7%) fairways on TOUR.

David Toms has improved his play in several areas of his game including his approach shots. Toms went from 112th in SG: Approach the Green in the 2014-15 PGA TOUR season to 43rd last season.

Peter Malnati

Defending Champion of the Sanderson Farms Championship, Peter Malnati finished 104th in the final FedExCup standings last season. After making his first 6 out of 7 cuts on TOUR last season, Malnati went on to miss 20 of his next 22 events on TOUR. However, Malnati is coming off 5 consecutive made cuts on TOUR dating back to last season.

Peter made the 2nd longest average feet of putts made in an event by a winner on TOUR since 2003. His impressive performance on the greens included 16 putts made from over 10 feet.
