## 2017 SBS Tournament of Champions Broadcast Window \& Pre-Tournament Notes



ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jordan Spieth
Jordan Spieth became only the $2^{\text {nd }}$ player in PGA TOUR history to post a score of 30-under par or better in a 72- hole PGA TOUR event at the 2016 SBS Tournament of Champions.

Spieth's total of 30 -under par at the 2016 SBS Tournament of Champions was $2^{\text {nd }}$ lowest to Ernie Els who posted 31-under par at this event in 2003.

Jordan Spieth dominated in all facets of the game, including approach shots from outside of 200 yards. In 19 attempts from over 200 yards in the fairway, no one was better than Spieth who averaged 38' 9" compared to the field average of $55^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$. His accuracy from long approach shots helped him take advantage of the par 5's at Kapalua playing them at a combined 16-under par. His 16 -under par on the 5 pars were 7 shots better than the field and 2 shots better than the next best player(s) at 14 -under par. Jordan's 16 -under par performance on the par 5's at Kapalua matched the best at this event (Ernie Els 16 in 2003).

## Short Game \& Putting Key on the Plantation Course at Kapalua:

9 of the last 10 SBS Tournament of Champions winners have ranked in the top 10 for SG: Around-the-Green en route to their respective victories. Jordan Spieth led the field in SG: Around-the-Green outperforming the field by +0.898 strokes per round at the Plantation Course. 4 of the last 10 winners have led the field for putts gained en route to victory. 8 of the last 10 winners have ranked inside the top 10 for SG: Putting en route to their victory. Patrick Reed (2015) \& Zach Johnson (2014) were the only exceptions ranking $16^{\text {th }} \& 17^{\text {th }}$ in SG: Putting. Jordan Spieth was the $1^{\text {st }}$ player to lead the field in SG: Putting en route to victory since Geoff Ogilvy in 2010.

The Plantation Course at Kapalua has been ranked inside the top 5 for the easiest course on TOUR in 8 of the last 9 seasons.

Kapalua has some of the largest greens on the PGA TOUR and therefore are the easiest greens to hit on TOUR. While the course has yielded the easiest greens to hit in 12 of the last 14 years, it's ranked among the toughest in terms of getting the ball close to the pin ranking inside the top 15 toughest in 13 of the last 14 years.

## The 400 Yard Mark

Since 2003, there have been 388 drives of 400 yards or more recorded on the PGA TOUR.

226 of the 388 total 400+ yard drives recorded on the PGA TOUR in last 14 years have come from the SBS Tournament of Champions on the Plantation Course at Kapalua. This works out $58 \%$ of all $400+$ yard drives originating at the Plantation Course.

However, in 2014, there were no drives recorded over 400 yards on the Plantation Course at Kapalua for the first time in the ShotLink Era. In fact, only 1 drive was recorded on TOUR in the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season over 400+ yards (Bubba Watson, Firestone CC (South) - 424 yards). Last season, this event recorded 3 of the 8 drives $400+$ for the season.

The par $5-18^{\text {th }}$ hole on the Plantation Course at Kapalua is responsible for nearly $1 / 4$ of all 400 yard drives on the PGA TOUR in the last 14 years ( 93 of $388-24 \%$ ).

On 2 measured drives per round for each player conducted on holes \#3 and \#15 at the Plantation Course the longest average drives was last season where players averaged nearly 288 yards off the tee.

However, 2013 the field average in driving distance was the lowest since 2002 with a distance of 254.16 yards.

In 2016, the 2 measured driving distance holes (\#3 and \#15) averaged 287.7 yards. This marked the longest average measured drives since 2002.
