ShotLink Keys to Victory for Bubba Watson

Bubba Watson vaulted from 105th to 11th in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the 2016 Genesis Open. Bubba converted just one of his first seven 54-hole leads / co-leads into victories on the PGA TOUR. However, he has since converted 2 of his last 3 into victories including the 2014 Masters and the 2016 Genesis Open.

Bubba Watson had just 5 over par holes for the week (T-fewest in field with Leishman). He was solid around the greens ranking 4th in the field for Scrambling salvaging par or better on 16 of 21 missed greens (76.2%).

Key Stats: Bubba Watson performed well in a number of areas en route to victory at the 2016 Genesis Open. He was the 5th longest off the tee (all drives) averaging 295.3 yards from the tee out driving the field average by nearly 12 yards. He was solid with his iron play as well ranking T-7th for greens in regulation and 6th for proximity to the hole for the week.

Since 2007, Bubba Watson has ranked outside of the top 30, 6 times at this point of any PGA TOUR season. In his last 2 seasons where he has ranked over 75th after week #12 he has finished inside of the top 30 by seasons end. This season, Bubba ranks 158th in the FedExCup standings and is seeking to make it to the TOUR Championship for the 8th time in his career.

Bubba Watson has been dominating the TOUR off the tee ranking 1st in SG: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the TOUR by +1.363 strokes per round. However, is play from on and around the green have been struggling ranking 206 of 215 ranked players in SG: Around-the-Green & 212 of 215 in SG: Putting.

Jordan Spieth picked up his 9th PGA TOUR victory becoming the 2nd youngest player to win 9 times on TOUR since WWII (Tiger Woods (23,5) 1999 Memorial Tournament, Jack Nicklaus (24) 1964 WMPO))). Spieth moved from **16th to 3rd** in the FedExCup standings with his win at the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Justin Thomas trails FedExCup points leader Hideki Matsuyama by 83 points. Justin Thomas is the only player who could overtake the #1 position in the FedExCup standings this week.

Jason Day is in search of his 11th PGA TOUR victory and 10th since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season. Day is coming off of a T-5th place finish at last week's AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and was the 3rd biggest mover in the FedExCup standings going from 131st to 75th in the FEC standings.
