

2017 THE NORTHERN TRUST Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes

THE NORTHERN TRUST serves as the start of the FedExCup Playoffs - the entire season has built to this four-tournament stretch. There is more on the line than just a victory at THE NORTHERN TRUST - players in the top half of the 125 will be looking to move up, working towards the coveted top-five position heading to the TOUR Championship; players near the 100th position need enough points to advance to the Dell Technologies Championship (top-100). The top 125 players on the FedExCup points list qualify for THE NORTHERN TRUST.

Potential #1 Scenario's at THE NORTHERN TRUST

38 Players Can Move to #1: 38 players in the field are currently within 2,000 points of the #1 ranked Hideki Matsuyama (last season 62 players were within 2,000 points of Jason Day) and can in turn potentially move to #1 with a victory this week. Ollie Schniederjans is the last player (39th position) who could possibly take over the #1 position. The 125th position currently owned by J.J. Henry is currently 2,504 points behind first place and could move as high as 5th with a victory.

Moving Week at THE NORTHERN TRUST

This is the first week where point values are quadrupled (4x their Regular Season value). Prior to this week event winners would receive 500 points (regular events) where now they will receive 2,000 points. THE NORTHERN TRUST has traditionally served as the catalyst event to make substantial moves in the FedExCup standings.

Entering the 2009 THE NORTHERN TRUST, **Heath Slocum** ranked 124th in the standings. His victory vaulted him 121 spots to 3rd and secured a spot at the TOUR Championship (largest move in the 10-year history of the FedExCup Playoffs).

Current FedExCup leader **Hideki Matsuyama** has led the standings for 13 of 39 weeks of the FedExCup standings on the strengths of three wins, and seven top-10s this season. Matsuyama moved from 3rd to 1st in the standings after his win at the WGC-Bridgestone Invitational.

Hideki Matsuyama (1st): This season, Matsuyama is the only player ranked inside the top-15 in SG: Off-the-Tee, SG: Approach-the-Green and SG: Around-the-Green.

Matsuyama ranks **2**nd on TOUR in SG: Tee-to-Green, outperforming the TOUR by **+1.782** strokes per round.

Martin Flores (118th): Martin Flores made a hole-in-one on the 16th hole in the final round at Wyndham Championship. Flores needing a strong finish to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs started the final round 134th in the FedExCup standings and moved inside and outside the 125 bubble for most of the day on Sunday. After his ace, Flores stuck his last two approach shots inside 12 feet. Flores needed a birdie or better on his last two holes to likely lock up his spot in the Playoffs.
