SCORING IN STROKE PLAY (Rule 6-6)

After each hole the marker should check the score with the competitor and record it. On completion of the round the marker shall sign the card and hand it to the competitor.

The competitor should check his score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the PGA TOUR Rules Committee. He shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card himself, and return it to the Committee immediately.

Ouestions as to the Rules of Golf shall be referred to the Rules committee.
