FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW:

CARLOS FRANCO (-15) VIJAY SINGH

Q. How would you assess your 12-under par round?

VIJAY SINGH: The way we played yesterday, it was really cold and miserable and we were really disappointed. Carlos played really well yesterday. I mean, to finish 3 under, we played well. But today was another story. He started off great, and every other hole we made birdie and we just kept going. We ham-and-egged it really well today.

Q. I was going to say you spoke pretty good on 18 right there on that birdie putt?

CARLOS FRANCO: Well, I never forget my partner because he played well today and I'm so happy.

Q. Vijay, just tell me, my goodness, you guys just tore it up on the front and then coming in as well?

VIJAY SINGH: Yeah, when I was out of the hole, Carlos made a putt, and when Carlos was out, I made it. So we played a great partner game today. My putter was hot, it made it lot easier, too.

Q. Tell me about being on this Champions Tour and how much fun are you having.

VIJAY SINGH: Well, if I play like today, I'm having a lot of fun. It's good. I mean, it's a start. You'll probably see a lot more of me on the Champions Tour coming up.

Q. Carlos, lots of guys still out there. Your thoughts as you sit on this four-stroke lead, I guess? I think three-stroke lead now.

CARLOS FRANCO: I never see who is the leader and I have to finish the last hole because my partner needed a birdie there, to make a birdie again.

Q. Vijay, what about you with the guys still out there?

VIJAY SINGH: There's a lot of birdie chances, every hole's a birdie chance. We're just going to hang in and see what happens. Whatever happens, happens.
