

Q. Good round today, yeah?

LEE JANZEN: 66 is a good start. Even if it was in last place, it's still a good start and highly unlikely to be in last place. And I had opportunities to do better, but there were plenty of good things that I did. I hit a lot of good bunker shots, I holed three really good par putts and I drove the ball exceptionally well. So if I continue to drive the ball like that, maybe just to be a little tighter with my wedges. I had a lot of in-between yardages, sometimes a littler harder to get it close to the hole. So I can work on that, that's something that I can improve. And I hit some good putts that didn't go in. Maybe I lost a little or had a little doubt on my reads and maybe missed a couple other ones, but 66 is a really good start. I hit a great iron shot on 7 and converted the putt for eagle and that was after I holed a bunker shot for eagle on 4.

Q. How far was that eagle on 4?

LEE JANZEN: Probably 40 feet.

Q. And then --

LEE JANZEN: It was a pretty vanilla bunker shot really. I had plenty of green to work with so I just had to splash it out. It was going a little firm when it went in, but I would have had a pretty good chance of making birdie.

Q. And your other eagle, how far was the putt?

LEE JANZEN: I hit a 3-iron dead pin high maybe 10 feet left of the hole. It was a great spot to be putting from.

Q. What did you do in the offseason, just take it easy?

LEE JANZEN: It wasn't much of an offseason because we just played the Father-Son a month ago. That's probably why my bunker game's good because I spent a lot of time with my son working on his bunker game. Whenever I'm helping somebody else with their chipping and putting and bunker game, my game improves, so that was good. We just played the Diamond Resorts in Orlando last week, which was a great warmup rather than being here trying to get a feel for where my game is because no matter how much we practice, once the tournament starts, there's always a little bit of an adjustment. So I felt like I had already had a tournament under my belt coming in here, so that was good.
