
Q. Well, how did it go out there today?

KIRK TRIPLETT: It was just a walk in the park. Anytime you play with Rocco and his caddie Martin, they keep loose. I played here a few times and really stayed calm. You really have to double check your instincts. There are some holes you're used to hitting shots into the wind and it's just playing a little bit shorter, the greens are a little more receptive. The golf course is in such good condition, there's just a huge volume of low scores. Just got to keep shooting at it.

Q. Birdies are almost like par? Wouldn't go that far?

KIRK TRIPLETT: You have to stay aggressive. The pins, if you look out there on 18, if you miss it right or long, you're going to be in that bunker and not be able to get it up and down. But there's always a safe side. This course has these flat 25- and 30-footers. If you make a couple of those, you just feel like I can play from the middle of the green all day and shoot a good score. 13 under, probably not going to be leading, so that means I need to do just as well as I did today. It depends on the weather, too. It could blow 25 miles an hour and 70 might be a great score tomorrow. So you have to adapt a little bit, but for the most part you're going to have to come out here and expect to make birdies.
