








Extended forecast – High pressure will work to suppress the marine layer and any fog potential again on Friday morning. An upper level low will swing into the Pacific Northwest on Friday afternoon, cooling temperatures slightly for the weekend and likely increasing the depth of the marine layer. Fog may become possible Saturday and Sunday morning, and would likely burn off by 8am if it did develop. Breezy winds are forecast for Friday afternoon, with gusts of 20-25 mph. The weekend will also see winds gust up to 20 mph in the afternoon.
