Extended forecast – A few clouds will drift into central IL by Sunday morning in advance of a cold front that will reach the Mississippi River. This boundary will slowly work its way to the area late in the day, resulting in increasing showers and storms later in the afternoon and through the evening. Temperatures will manage to reach 90 before that occurs though, with heat index values near or exceeding 100. Southerly winds will increase during the afternoon Sunday, blow from 10 – 20 mph.
