Extended Forecast – Tropical moisture will remain in place through the end of the week with the potential for scattered afternoon showers and T-storms. Highest coverage is expected Thursday. While somewhat drier air should arrive late Friday, rain chances have been raised for this weekend as confidence has increased on an upper level disturbance dropping into the Carolinas. Temperatures near 90 Thursday/Friday will cool slightly this weekend as winds turn northerly.
