Today – Dry conditions will occur for much of this morning, however a cold front dropping southward out of Virginia should kick off numerous showers and T-storms this afternoon. Highest chances are expected between 2-6pm. Most of this activity diminishes by 7pm. Temperatures today will climb into the middle 80s. Light westerly winds become northerly behind the front.

Extended Forecast – Most of the shower and T-storm activity will end early this evening with just an isolated shower possible overnight. Low pressure will be situated off the North Carolina coastline on Sunday with shower/T-storm chances remaining possible around the Raleigh area. Coverage of this activity should be less widespread compared to Saturday. Cooler and drier air will finally spread across the region on Monday.
