ShotLink Keys to Victory for Xander Schauffele

Xander Schauffele won his first PGA TOUR victory in his 23rd career start. Schauffele moved from 94th to 27th in the FedExCup standings. With his win at A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier last season, marked the first time Xander ranked inside the top 30 of the standings in his PGA TOUR career.

Xander Schauffele became the seventh player to rank inside the top 10 in both SG: Off-the-Tee and SG: Putting to go onto win last season. Xander ranked second in SG: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the field by +1.218 strokes per round.

Xander Schauffele ranked sixth in SG: Putting, outperforming the field by +1.438 strokes per round on the greens, marking the 14th winner last season to rank inside the top 10 in SG: Putting.

Off-the-Tee & On-the-Green Performance Entering 2017 Greenbrier vs Week

Xander Schauffele ranked second in SG: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the field by +1.218 strokes per round. Schauffele averaged 102' 6" of putts made per round on the greens at The Old White TPC, 23 feet of putts made per round more than his season average (79' 6").
